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# DIVINE STRATEGIES: LIVING TO FULFIL GOD'S DIVINE PURPOSE FOR YOUR LIFE

**T**he Church held School of Christian Growth Open Sessions on three consecutive Friday evenings beginning from 25 July 2008. Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam taught us divine strategies to handle the turbulences, testing and temptations that we face in these challenging days.

## Session 1: Burn Your Boats

Senior Pastor began his teaching from Matthew 4:18-22, a passage about the call of two pairs of brothers, "busy people at their careers" who left their nets immediately when He called them. God has a plan and purpose for all who believe in Him. God's call does not have to match where we are spiritually. Jesus understands our shortcomings as He did Simon Peter's. We are all "marred when we come to the potter's hands" (Jeremiah 18:3-4). Senior Pastor encouraged us to let the Potter make us into vessels fit for His use.

Senior Pastor said, "You will not automatically love and accept the call of God". There is a constant struggle between the old self, "Simon" and the new, "Peter", in us. In our weakness, we often regress to past familiarity like Peter seeking comfort in his former occupation as a fisherman. So often we are not in positions God desires us to be in because of self-satisfaction or defeat by adversities. We were encouraged by what Jesus told Peter. Satan had asked to sift him like wheat but Jesus is ever praying for us like He prayed for Peter, that our faith will not fail (Luke 22:31-34).

In order to come into the fullness of our destiny, we must "burn our boats" so that we cannot return to them. Moses' boat was Egypt. Abraham's was Lot and Samson's was his relationship with Delilah. Senior Pastor challenged us to ask ourselves what our "boats" are. With Christ, indeed we do not need a 'back-up'. He is our complete security. Faith in Him is the currency for all that we need. God will protect you when you do His will.

## Session 2: The Yoke Will Be Destroyed

Senior Pastor said that we, the called, would face adversities but God has faith in us and will protect us when we walk in obedience. He expounded on Isaiah 10:24-27, saying that we are not to despise difficult times as they are designed to bring

the church to "a different level."

Do not be afraid of the "Assyrians who beat you with a rod."

We were encouraged to hear that nothing happens to a child of God without His permission. Being tested shows us that we are being transformed for good. From Job 1:8-12, we learn that evil forces are permitted to test our faith. In another illustration, Senior Pastor pointed out that the Israelites had become comfortable in Egypt till they were turned into slaves. Their affliction turned their focus once again towards the Promised Land. Hebrews 12:6-8 says that sonship is proven by correction from God.

The enemy puts a yoke of bondage on us limiting our freedom but God destroys the yoke with His anointing oil. If a yoke is merely broken, it may mean the possibility of it being 'mended' by the devil. Living under the anointing destroys the yoke permanently. If Jesus needed anointing, how much more we need it too in order that we be effective to do the will of the Lord.

## Session 3: Die to Live

The text for the final session was from Matthew 10:34-39: "Do not think I come to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword." Love for God should take priority over everything else. There will naturally be conflict when we choose to follow God.

We are exhorted to take up the cross for His sake. The cross is "an instrument of death." Senior Pastor clarified that in Scripture, death is not annihilation. It is a portal or door to an enhanced life. Death to self then causes us to come into everything that God has for us. Psalms 116:15 says, "Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of His saints."

Matthew 8:18-22 tells us of two individuals, a scribe and a disciple, who approached Jesus and expressed a desire to follow him. Jesus addressed the issue of their attachment to fleshly comforts and family responsibilities and said, "Let the dead bury their own dead". Clinging on to things deprive us of spiritual power. Senior Pastor concluded by giving us four areas in which we are to die in order that we live. We are to die to sin, to our wills, to self and to self glory.

We were greatly challenged and blessed by these three sessions. +

(Colossians 3:17, 23). A woman would be happy to submit to a husband who loves her as Christ loves the Church.

### Parents and children

The priority of a Christian parent is to train their children in the Lord (Proverbs 22:6). Training is a repeated action and soon becomes a way of life. Children will not forget what they have been taught and practised over and over again. They may stray for awhile but the promise of God is that they will return.

Three kinds of love, *agape* – unconditional love, *phileo* – brotherly love and *eros* – sexual love must be functional within a strong marriage. For a strong parent-child relationship, *agape* and *phileo* love must be practised.

We benefited from these sessions with Sister Petrina who interspersed her lessons with interesting life illustrations and practical tips that helped us to apply the Godly principles that were expounded. +

# BUILDING STRONG FAMILIES

In another School of Christian Growth Open Session held on two consecutive Friday evenings, 19 and 26 September 2008, Senior Associate Pastor Petrina Guneratnam gave us rich lessons on building strong families. Over the two sessions, Sister Petrina covered the following aspects:

### Fundamental Principles in Home Life

It is important that families spend quality time together as most problems begin in the home. Marriage is the first institution ordained by God before sin entered the world and as such it is imperative that we follow God's blueprint for strong families found in Colossians 3:18-21. We are to know our **position** as written in Colossians 3:1 that we are "risen with Christ"; our **pursuit** – to "seek those things above" (Colossians 3:2-3); and our **prospect** – to "appear with Him in glory" (Colossians.3:4).

A strong Christian family is dependent on a strong Christian. Psalm 101:1-2 says, "I will try to walk a blameless path, but how I need Your help, especially in my own home where I long to act as I should (paraphrased)." What this means is that as each spouse anchors him or herself on the solidity of his or her relationship with Christ, they are more capable of being loving and acting righteously to each other and their children.

### Wisdom for Wives, Help for Husbands

Christians should function within our God-given roles in the family. The husband, the head of the family, has a directive role. The wife, however, is to submit to him in a supportive role. Children in turn are to obey their parents. They play a learning role to parents who have the responsibility to teach by lifestyle.

Eve wrongly assumed the directive role in Genesis 3. It was then that the "first blame game" ensued. The true way in a marriage is that each partner recognise that they are individually accountable to God and should "look into the Word, excel in their respective roles of wife, husband, mother and father." Submission should be "as is fitting in the Lord"

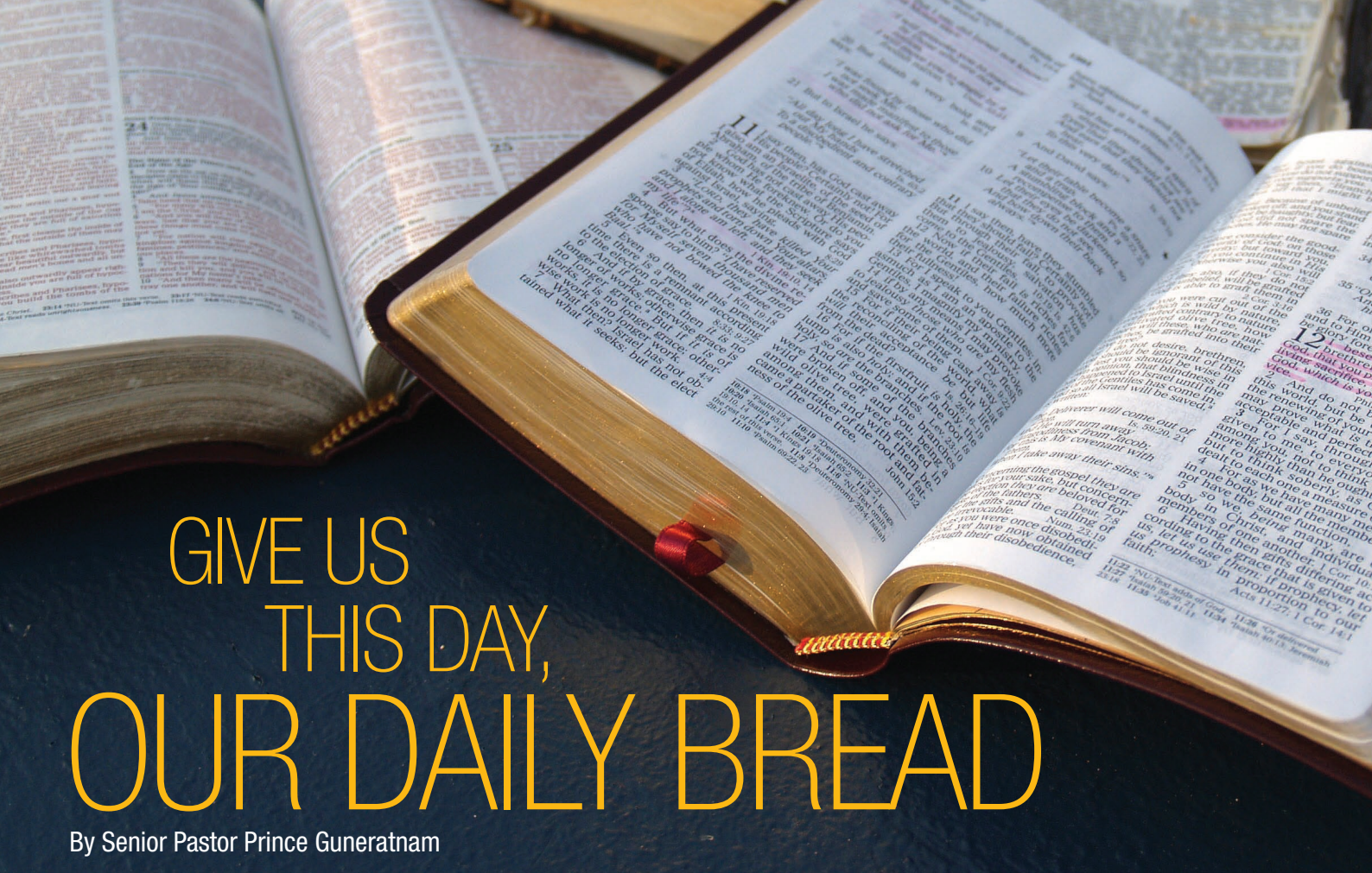
## HOE WEE FANG (Kota Kemuning Home LG)

# GIVE US THIS DAY, OUR DAILY BREAD

**W**hen teaching His disciples to pray, Jesus said, “In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen” (Matthew 6:9-13)

Our Father in heaven is a giving God. Giving began with God. The Bible says, **“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life”** (John 3:16).

There are many Scriptural accounts to support this fact that God is a giver. Apostle Paul says, **“And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus”** (Philippians 4:19). In the Old Testament, one of His names is Jehovah Jireh, the Lord who provides (Genesis 22:14). Luke

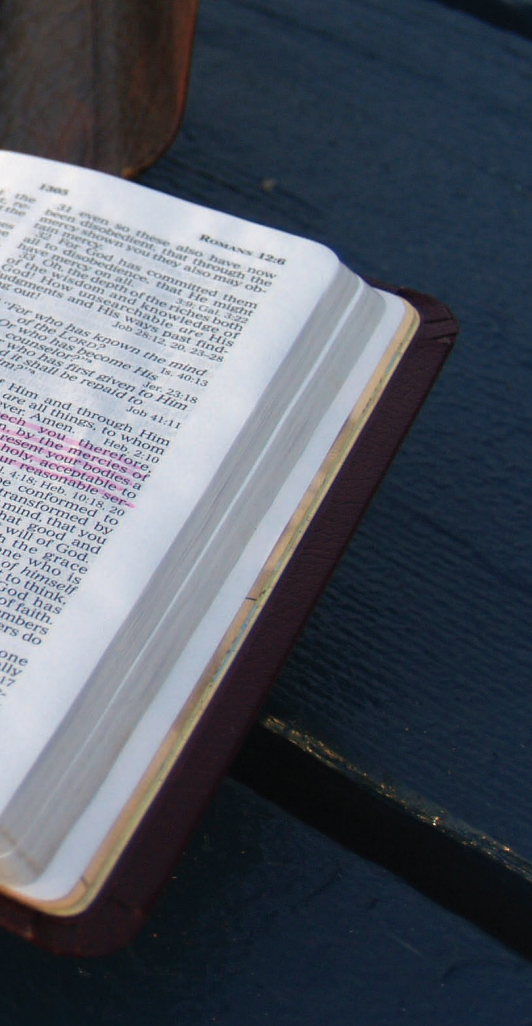
records that Jesus fed five thousand, not including women and children, with five loaves and two fish and there were twelve baskets to spare. After His resurrection, Jesus cooked breakfast for His disciples (John 21:12-14)! Jesus also gave to His disciples, power and authority over the enemy (Luke 10:1, 19). Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to all who ask (Luke 11:13). You must believe that God the Father is a giver.

Jesus teaches us to pray, **“Give us this day our daily bread.”** Just as yesterday’s provision is not sufficient for today, so you need to pray for your daily needs. You cannot expect to live a victorious Christian life if you only pray on Sunday when you go to church. You need to daily seek God and ask Him to strengthen, guide and provide for you. Ask Him to fill you afresh and anew with the Holy Spirit. Daily devotions are therefore important.

The Bible says, **“Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God”** (Luke 4:4). While we need to be strengthened physically, we also need to be strengthened spiritually. When you pray for your daily bread, pray first for your spiritual well being because spiritual blessings have far greater eternal value than material blessings. Your spiritual

man can take care of your physical or natural man while your physical man cannot take care of your spiritual man. If you have fellowship with God, you will become spiritually strong and physically healthy. The spiritual man will help the natural man to be healthy and successful in life. The Bible says, **“Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ”** (1 Thessalonians 5:23).

Jesus teaches what should be our priority when we pray. He says, **“But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you”** (Matthew 6:33). Jesus illustrated this in the parable of the rich fool: **“The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully. And he thought within himself, saying, ‘What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?’ So he said, ‘I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods. And I will say to my soul, ‘Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, and be merry.’”** But God said to him, **‘Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those**

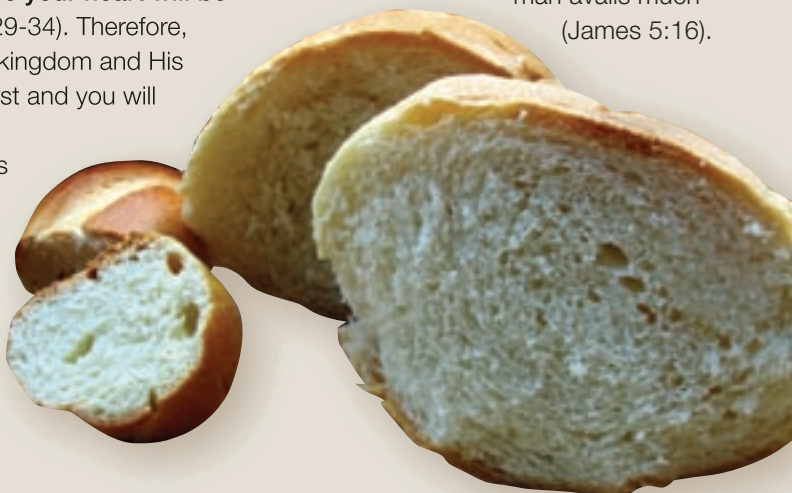


things be which you have provided? So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God" (Luke 12:16-21). Jesus added, "And do not seek what you should eat or what you should drink, nor have an anxious mind. For all these things the nations of the world seek after, and your Father knows that you need these things. But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you. Do not fear, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Luke 12:29-34). Therefore, seek first God's kingdom and His righteousness first and you will be blessed.

Jesus teaches us true values. He asks, "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and

loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul" (Matthew 16:26)? There is nothing wrong with material things but your priority must be right. Paul says, "So then each of us shall give account of himself to God" (Romans 14:12). He also says, "If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above" (Colossians 3:1-2).

Prayer is vital for your spiritual well being. Pray that you will bear the fruit of the Spirit in your life: "love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Galatians 5:22-23) and pray for the gifts of the Holy Spirit: "for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues" (1 Corinthians 12:8-10). Our God, who is our father, is the source of our life and spiritual well being. The Bible says, "For in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring'" (Acts 17:28). When your life is pleasing to God and your priorities are right, you can pray for everything else: your family and friends, circumstances, the church, the nation and others. The Bible says, "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (James 5:16).



### Let me share some steps you need to know when you pray:

1. Start with a right relationship with God. "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you" (John 15:7).
2. Ask, seek and knock. The Bible says, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened" (Matthew 7:7-8).
3. Give. Jesus says, "Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you" (Luke 6:38). Give God your life and your resources. Do not hold back anything. When you give in the name of God, He becomes responsible. The measure you use to give determines the measure you will receive (Matthew 7:2).
4. Believe and have faith. Jesus says, "Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them" (Mark 11:24). Do not reason with faith. If you reason with faith, you reason yourself out of faith. Faith is supernatural and spiritual. If God promises, He will do it. Do not doubt.
5. Persevere in prayer. The Bible says, "Men always ought to pray and not lose heart" (Luke 18:1) and "pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Be specific when you pray. Resist the devil and speak faith.

Pray, expecting to receive from Him. +

Alkitab berkata, “**Karena begitu besar kasih Allah akan dunia ini, sehingga Ia telah mengaruniakan Anak-Nya yang tunggal, supaya setiap orang yang percaya kepada-Nya tidak binasa, melainkan beroleh hidup yang kekal**” (Yohanes 3:16).

Ada banyak pernyataan dalam Alkitab yang menyokong hakikat ini bahawa Tuhan ialah pemberi. Rasul Paulus

berkata, “**Allahku akan memenuhi segala keperluanmu menurut kekayaan dan kemuliaan-Nya dalam Kristus Yesus**” (Filipi 4 :19). Di dalam Perjanjian Lama, salah satu daripada namaNya ialah Jehovah Jireh, Tuhan yang menyediakan (Kejadian 22:14). Lukas mencatat bahawa Yesus memberi makanan kepada lima ribu, tidak termasuk wanita-wanita dan kanak-kanak, dengan lima buku roti dan dua ekor ikan dan ada dua belas bakul berlebihan. Selepas kebangkitanNya, Yesus memasak sarapan pagi untuk pengikut-pengikutNya (Yohanes 21:12-14). Yesus juga memberi pengikut-pengikutNya kuasa dan autoriti ke atas musuh (Lukas 10:1,19). Yesus memberi Roh Kudus kepada semua yang meminta (Lukas 11:13). Kamu mesti percaya bahawa Bapa Tuhan ialah pemberi.

Yesus mengajar kita berdoa, “**Berikanlah kami pada hari ini makanan kami yang secukupnya.**” Sama seperti pembekalan semalam tidak mencukupi untuk hari ini, kamu perlu berdoa untuk keperluan setiap hari. Kamu tidak boleh berharap untuk menjalani satu kehidupan Kristian yang membawa kemenangan sekiranya kamu hanya berdoa pada hari Ahad apabila kamu pergi ke gereja. Kamu perlu mencari Tuhan setiap hari dan memintanya untuk menguatkan, memimpin dan membekalkan untuk

kamu. Minta Dia untuk memenuhi, menyegarkan dan memperbaharui kamu dengan Roh Kudus. Maka itu, renungan rohani harian adalah penting.

Alkitab berkata, “**Ada tertulis: Manusia hidup bukan dari roti saja**” (Lukas 4:4). Sementara kita perlu dikuatkan dari segi fizikal, kita juga perlu dikuatkan dari segi rohani. Apabila kamu berdoa untuk makanan harian, berdoa dahulu untuk kesejahteraan rohani kamu kerana berkat rohani mengandungi nilai abadi yang jauh lebih besar daripada harta duniawi. Manusia rohani kamu boleh menjaga manusia jasmaniah kamu manakala manusia jasmaniah tidak boleh menjaga manusia rohani kamu. Jika kamu ada persekutuan dengan Tuhan, kamu akan menjadi kuat dari segi rohani dan juga fizikal. Manusia rohani akan menolong manusia jasmaniah untuk menjadi sihat dan berjaya dalam kehidupan. Alkitab berkata, “**Semoga Allah damai sejahtera menguduskan kamu seluruhnya dan semoga roh, jiwa dan tubuhmu terpelihara sempurna dengan tak bercacat pada kedatangan Yesus Kristus Tuhan kita**” (1 Tesalonika 5:23).

Yesus mengajar apa yang sepatutnya menjadi keutamaan kita apabila kita berdoa. Dia berkata, “**Tetapi carilah dahulu Kerajaan Allah dan kebenaranNya, maka semuanya itu akan ditambahkan kepadamu**” (Matius 6:33). Yesus memberi contoh ini dengan perumpamaan tentang orang kaya yang bodoh: “**Kemudian Ia mengatakan kepada mereka suatu perumpamaan, kata-Nya: “Ada seorang kaya, tanahnya berlimpah-limpah hasilnya. Ia bertanya dalam hatinya: Apakah yang harus aku perbuat, sebab aku tidak mempunyai tempat di mana aku dapat menyimpan hasil tanahku. Lalu katanya: Inilah yang akan aku perbuat; aku akan merombak lumbung-lumbungku dan aku akan mendirikan yang lebih besar dan aku akan menyimpan di dalamnya segala gandum dan barang-barangku. Sesudah itu aku akan berkata kepada jiwaku: Jiwaku, ada padamu banyak barang, tertimbun untuk bertahun-tahun lamanya; beristirahatlah,**



makanlah, minumlah dan bersenang-senanglah! Tetapi Firman Allah kepadanya: Hai engkau orang bodoh, pada malam ini juga jiwamu akan diambil dari padamu, dan apa yang telah kau sediakan, untuk siapakah itu nanti? Demikianlah jadinya dengan orang yang mengumpulkan harta bagi dirinya sendiri, jikalau ia tidak kaya di hadapan Allah” (Lukas 12:16-21). Yesus menambah, “Jadi, janganlah kamu mempersoalkan apa yang akan kamu makan atau apa yang akan kamu minum dan janganlah cemas hatimu. Semua itu dicari bangsa-bangsa di dunia yang tidak mengenal Allah. Akan tetapi Bapamu tahu, bahwa kamu memang memerlukan semuanya itu. Tetapi carilah Kerajaan-Nya, maka semuanya itu akan ditambahkan juga kepadamu. Janganlah takut, hai kamu kawan-kawan kecil! Karena Bapamu telah berkenan memberikan kamu Kerajaan itu. Juallah segala milikmu dan berikanlah sedekah! Buatlah bagimu pundi-pundi yang tidak dapat menjadi tua, suatu harta di sorga yang tidak akan habis, yang tidak dapat didekati pencuri dan yang tidak dirusakkan ngenat. Karena di mana hartamu berada, di situ juga hatimu berada” (Lukas 12:29-34). Jadi, carilah dahulu kerajaan Allah dan kebenaranNya dan

kamu akan diberkati.

Yesus mengajar kita nilai-nilai yang benar. Dia bertanya, “Apa gunanya seorang memperoleh seluruh dunia tetapi kehilangan nyawanya? Dan apakah yang dapat diberikannya sebagai ganti nyawanya” (Matius 16:26)? Benda duniawi tidak bersalah tetapi kamu mesti mengutamakan yang betul. Paulus berkata, “Demikianlah setiap orang di antara kita akan memberi pertanggungjawaban tentang dirinya sendiri kepada Allah” (Roma 14:12). Dia juga bercakap, “Karena itu, kalau kamu dibangkitkan bersama dengan Kristus, carilah perkara yang di atas, di mana Kristus ada, duduk di sebelah kanan Allah. Pikirkanlah perkara yang di atas, bukan yang di bumi” (Kolose 3:1-2).

Doa penting untuk kesejahteraan rohani kamu. Berdoa supaya kamu menghasilkan buah Roh dalam kehidupan kamu: “kasih, sukacita, damai sejahtera, kesabaran, kemurahan, kebaikan, kesetiaan, kelemahlembutan, penguasaan diri” (Galatia 5 :22-23) dan berdoa untuk anugerah Roh Kudus: “Sebab kepada yang seorang Roh memberikan karunia untuk berkata-kata dengan hikmat, dan kepada yang lain Roh yang sama memberikan karunia

berkata-kata dengan pengetahuan. Kepada yang seorang Roh yang sama memberikan iman, dan kepada yang lain la memberikan karunia untuk menyembuhkan. Kepada yang seorang Roh memberikan kuasa untuk mengadakan mujizat, dan kepada yang lain la memberikan karunia untuk bernubuat, dan kepada yang lain lagi la memberikan karunia untuk membedakan bermacam-macam roh. Kepada yang seorang la memberikan karunia untuk berkata-kata dengan bahasa roh, dan kepada yang lain la memberikan karunia untuk menafsirkan bahasa roh itu” (1 Korintus 12:8-10). Tuhan kita, iaitu bapa kita, adalah sumber kehidupan dan kesejahteraan rohani kita. Alkitab berkata, “Sebab di dalam Dia kita hidup, kita bergerak, kita ada, seperti yang telah juga dikatakan oleh pujangga-pujanggamu: Sebab kita ini dari keturunan Allah juga” (Kisah Para Rasul 17:28). Apabila kehidupan kamu menyenangkan Tuhan dan keutamaan kamu betul, kamu boleh berdoa untuk segala-galanya yang lain: keluarga dan kawan-kawan kamu, situasi-situasi, gereja, negara dan lain-lain. Alkitab berkata, “Doa orang yang benar, bila dengan yakin didoakan, sangat besar kuasanya” (Yakobus 5:16).

### Biar saya kongsi beberapa langkah yang kamu perlu tahu apabila kamu berdoa:

1. Mulakan dengan hubungan yang betul dengan Tuhan. “Jikalau kamu tinggal di dalam Aku dan firman-Ku tinggal di dalam kamu, mintalah apa saja yang kamu kehendaki, dan kamu akan menerimanya” (Yohanes 15:7).
2. Minta, cari dan ketuk. Alkitab berkata, “Mintalah, maka akan diberikan kepadamu; carilah, maka kamu akan mendapat; ketoklah, maka pintu akan dibukakan bagimu. Karena setiap orang yang meminta, menerima dan setiap orang yang mencari, mendapat dan setiap orang yang mengetok, baginya pintu dibukakan” (Matius 7:7-8).
3. Beri, Yesus berkata, “Berilah dan

kamu akan diberi: suatu takaran yang baik, yang dipadatkan, yang digoncang dan yang tumpah ke luar akan dicurahkan ke dalam ribaanmu. Sebab ukuran yang kamu pakai untuk mengukur, akan diukurkan kepadamu” (Lukas 6:38). Berikan kepada Tuhan kehidupan dan semua milik kamu. Jangan berpegang balik apa-apa. Apabila kamu memberi dalam nama Tuhan, Dia bertanggungjawab. Ukuran yang kamu gunakan untuk memberi menentukan ukuran yang kamu akan terima (Matius 7:2).

4. Percaya dan miliki iman. Yesus berkata, “Karena itu Aku berkata kepadamu: apa saja yang kamu minta dan doakan, percayalah

bahwa kamu telah menerimanya, maka hal itu akan diberikan kepadamu” (Markus 11:24). Jangan berdebat dengan iman. Jika kamu berdebat dengan iman, kamu sendiri akan hilang iman. Iman adalah luarbiasa dan bersifat rohani. Jika Tuhan berjanji, Dia akan melakukannya. Jangan meraguiNya.

5. Tekun dalam doa. Alkitab berkata, “mereka harus selalu berdoa dengan tidak jemu-jemu” (Lukas 18:1) dan “tetaplah berdoa” (1 Tesalonika 5:17). Lafazkan yang tepat apabila kamu berdoa. Tolak iblis dan lafazkan iman.

Berdoa dan mengharap untuk menerima daripadaNya. +

# 我们日用的饮食， 今日赐给我们

**在** 教导门徒如何祷告时,耶稣说:  
「所以你们祷告,要这样说,  
我们在天上的父,  
愿人都尊你的名为圣。  
愿你的国降临,  
愿你的旨意行在地上,  
如同行在天上。  
我们日用的饮食,今日赐给我们。  
免我们的债,  
如同我们免了人的债。  
不叫我们遇见试探,  
救我们脱离凶恶,  
因为国度,权柄,荣耀,全是你的,直到永远,  
阿们」(太6:9-13)。

我们的天父是一位施予的神。施予始于神。圣经上说,「神爱世人,甚至将他的独生子赐给他们,叫一切信他的,不至灭亡,反得永生」(约3:16)。

有许多的圣经记载支持上帝是一位施予者。使徒保罗说,「我的神必照他荣耀的丰富,在基督耶稣里,使你们一切所需用的都充足」(腓4:19)。在旧约里,他的其中一个名字叫做耶和与华以勒,耶和与华必预备(创22:14)。路加福音记载耶稣以五个饼和二条鱼喂饱了五千人,不包括妇女和小孩在内,剩下的还装满了十二个篮子。在耶稣复活之后,他为他的门徒准备了早餐(约21:12-14)!耶稣也给他的门徒权柄和能力胜过仇敌(路10:1,19)。耶稣赐圣灵给所有求他的人(路11:13)。你必须相信天父是一位施予者。

耶稣教导我们为「我们日用的饮食,今日赐给我们」祷告。正如昨天的供应是不够今天用,因此你需要为每天的需要祈求。你不能够期望有基督徒得胜的生活如果你只在星期天去教会时才祷告。你需要每天寻求神和祈求他加力量,指引和供给你。祈求他再把圣灵浇灌于你和更新你。所以每天的灵修是很重要。

圣经上说,「人活着不是单靠食物,乃是靠神口里所出的一切话」(路4:4)。虽然我们需要使身体强壮,我们也需要坚强的属灵能力。当你为每日的饮食祈求时,先要为你的属灵健康祈求因为属灵的祝福比物质的祝福有更大的永恒价值。你属灵的人能够照顾你属身体或自然的人,而你属身体的人却不能够照顾你属灵的人。如果你与神有交通,你就会属灵坚强有力和身体健康。属灵的人 would 帮助属肉体的人健康和有成功的人生。圣经上说,「愿赐平安的神,亲自使你们全然成圣。又愿你们的灵,与魂,与身子,得蒙保守,在我主耶稣基督降临的时候,完全无可指摘」(帖前5:23)。

耶稣教导我们祷告时的优先次序。他说,「你们要先求他的国,和他的义。这些

东西都要加给你们了」(太6:33)。耶稣以无知的财主的比喻举例说明,「有一个财主,田产丰盛。自己心里思想说,我的出产没有地方收藏,怎么办呢。又说,我要这么办。要把我的仓房拆了,另盖更大的。在那里好收藏我一切的粮食和财物。然后要对我的灵魂说,灵魂哪,你有许多财物积存,可作多年的费用。只管安安逸逸的吃喝快乐吧。神却对他说,无知的人哪,今夜必要你的灵魂。你所预备的,要归谁呢。凡为自己积财,在神面前却不富足的,也是这样。」(路12:16-21)。耶稣又说,「你们不要要求吃什么,喝什么,也不要挂心。这都是外邦人所求的,你们必须用这些东西,你们的父是知道的。你们只要求他的国,这些东西就必加给你们了。你们这小群,不要惧怕,因为你们的父,乐意把国赐给你们。你们要变卖所有的,周济人。为自己预备永不坏的钱囊,用不尽的财宝在天上,就是贼不能近,虫不能蛀的地方。因为你们的财宝在那里,你们的心也在那里」(路12:29-34)。因此,要先求神的国和他的义,你就必蒙祝福。

耶稣教导我们真正的价值。他问,「人若赚得全世界,赔上自己的生命,有什么益处呢。人还能拿什么换生命呢」(太16:26)?物质的享用是没有错,但是你的优先次序必须正确。保罗说,「这样看来,我们各人必要将自己的事,在神面前说明。」(罗14:12)。他也说,「所以你们若真与基督一同复活,就当求在上面的事。那里有基督坐在神的右边。你们要思念上面的事,不要思念地上的事。」(西3:1-2)。

祷告对你的属灵健康非常重要。祈求你能在生命中结出圣灵的果子:「圣灵所结的果子,就是仁爱,喜乐,和平,忍耐,恩慈,良善,信实,温柔,节制」(加5:22-23)和祈求圣灵的恩赐,「这人蒙圣灵赐他智慧的言语。那人也蒙这位圣灵赐他知识的言语。又有一人蒙这位圣灵赐他信心的言语。还有一人蒙这位圣灵赐他医病的恩赐。又有一

- 3 施予。耶稣说,「你们要给人,就必有给你们。并且用十足的升斗,连摇带按,上尖下流的,倒在你们怀里。因为你们用什么量器量给人,也必用什么量器量给你们」(路6:38)。将你的生命和资源奉献给神。不要有任何保留。当你奉神的名施予时,他为我们负责任。你用什么量器量给人,也同样决定你所得到的数量(太7:2)。
- 4 相信和有信心。耶稣说,「所以我告诉你们,凡你们祷告祈求的,无论是什么,只要信是得着的,就必得着」(可11:24)。不要与信心理论。如果你与信心理论,你就失去信心。信心是超自然和属灵的。如果神应许,他必成就。不要疑惑。
- 5 坚持地祷告。圣经上说,「要人常常祷告,不可灰心」(路18:1)和「不住的祷告」(帖前5:17)。当你祈求时要明确说明。抵挡魔鬼和宣告信心。

祷告祈求和期待从他领受所求的。+
