A RACE TO WIN

(PART 1)

“Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God” (Hebrews 12:1-2).



The author of Hebrews describes living for Christ as a race. A race to be won by living a life approved by God. Like any athlete, Christians must be disciplined to win the race. It's a discipline that calls us to “lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us”. It is a race to be run with endurance, looking to Jesus, who is the author and finisher of our faith, who by example, “endured the cross, despising the shame, and has set down at the right hand of the throne of God”.

As an encouragement, the writer of Hebrews mentions that there is a great cloud of witnesses cheering us on, suggesting we are not alone. These are individuals before us, who have run the race successfully and won. In chapter eleven of Hebrews, we find a list of some of them.

- **“By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness**

that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and though it being dead still speaks” (Hebrews 11:4). Abel obeyed God and God blessed him.

- **“By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, ‘and was not found, because God had taken him for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God”** (Hebrews 11:5). In Genesis 5:22, it says, **“Enoch walked with God three hundred years.”** It has been said that Enoch walked so closely with God that God said to him, “Since you are closer to my house than yours, let Me take

you home.” And God took him home.

- **“By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith”** (Hebrews 11:7). Every wickedness of sin was rampant in the days of Noah. Living in sin was the normal way of life. But Noah obeyed God and saved his household from the flood.
- **“By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place**

which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going” (Hebrews 11:8).

- **“By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past age, because she judged Him faithful who**

had promised” (Hebrews 11:11).

Hebrews 11:32 says, **“And what more shall I say? For the time would fail me to tell of Gideon and Barak and Samson and Jephthah, also of David and Samuel and the prophets”** (Hebrews 11:32). There are more

witnesses as the writer of Hebrews says, “a great cloud of witnesses”.

This cloud of witnesses is growing and if Jesus does not return soon, your name could be added to the list.

This race requires discipline with perseverance. The discipline is two-fold. First, is a discipline to lay aside every weight. Second, to lay aside the sin that so easily besets us or causes us to fall.

1. A DISCIPLINE TO LAY ASIDE EVERY WEIGHT

To lay aside, simply means to put off, take off, to remove or to strip. Athletes understand this. For instance, before any boxing match, the boxers discipline themselves to take off excess body weight. This will qualify them with the right weight to meet their opponent and for them to be fit, stronger and able to take on their challengers. So, “laying-off” is about disciplining yourself with perseverance to be fit and strong to live the Christian life when faced with challenges.

Weights may not be sinful or wrong activities. They may be legitimate things or very innocent activities but they are not helpful to you and may be stumbling blocks. They are extra baggages that hinder you from being a winner. For instance, watching television may not be wrong. But if you are undisciplined in this area, it robs you of your time in having a regular prayer time and Bible study. The writer of Hebrews says we must lay aside or stop doing things that hinder and sins that so easily entangle you from being successful in running the race by being a testimony for God.

Jesus gives us a good example about a rich young ruler. Jesus said to him, **“If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me”** (Matthew 19:22). Note that the word ‘perfect’ here means you are not what you are supposed to be, you have a “weight” problem. Being rich is not sinful as many of the witnesses listed in Hebrews 11 were blessed with great possessions. But Jesus was referring to the issue of priorities in this rich young man’s life. In Matthew 19:16-24, we learn

that this young man’s question was, **“What good should I do that I might have eternal life?”** He went on to say that he had kept the commandments from his youth (v 20). This indicated that he was not living a sinful life. But God was not first in His life! In other words, Jesus was inviting him to put God first and walk with Him and he will find eternal life. But the young man was unwilling or unable to lay aside his “weights” which were his treasures (v 22).

Another example, “Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, that someone said to Him, **“Lord, I will follow You wherever You go.” And Jesus said to him, “Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head”** (Luke 9:57-58). Jesus asked him, if you have no place like me, would you still make a commitment to follow me? Are you ready to pay the price to live a godly life? Jesus said to another, **“Follow Me.’ But he said, ‘Lord, let me first go and bury my father”** (Luke 9:59). Jesus replied him, **“Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God”** (Luke 9:60). It is easy to miss the point intended by Jesus. Jesus was not saying that burying your father was wrong. Neither was He teaching the son to be disrespectful to his parents! The point intended or the teaching was to put God first above all else. Wrong priorities can be weights that hinder you from winning the race. The Christian race can be won by laying aside weights that hinder us and cause us to stumble and lose the race.

2. SINS THAT SO EASILY BESET US

Sins that easily beset us are sins that entangle us or bondages that control us. An example of such a sin is gossiping.

You gossip because you have no discipline in controlling your tongue. This is what the Bible says about the tongue, **“If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this one’s religion is useless”** (James 1:26) and **“And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell”** (James 3:6). **Therefore, Paul tells the Ephesian Christians, “... put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to deceitful lusts”** (Ephesians 4:22). We are to put off and be set free from all ungodly behaviour we had before we were saved. We are to seek deliverance to succeed in the Christian race. Jesus says, **“... Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses”** (Luke 12:15). Life does not consist of what you possess. John writes in 1 John 2:15, **“Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.”** Jesus commands us, **“You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’... And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself”** (Matthew 22:37;39).

As a Christian athlete, let us run to win. Let us lay aside every weight and the sin which so easily ensnares us. Let us keep our eyes on Jesus, who is the author and finisher of your faith. Your life will be a testimony for the glory of God!

A Fresh Encounter With God Deepens Our Prayer Life

“Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know” (Jeremiah 33:3).

A total of 689 Calvarites, including the kids, came for the Church’s first Prayer Rally on 14 March at Damansara Heights sanctuary and were blessed by God’s presence right from the pre-service prayer.

Associate Pastor David Seah, Tabitha Ong, Youth Leaders, and the Church choir led the congregation in praise and worship enthusiastically.

Then, Senior Associate Pastor Petrina Guneratnam opened with a word of prayer, calling for God’s heavenly

blessings to rain upon all Calvarites. A special number, “Lord, Revive Our Praying Heart” by the Chinese Ministry Ensemble soon followed.

In his exhortation, Senior Pastor Prince Guneratnam highlighted that prayer won’t work if we do not pray according to the way God had instructed us in the Scriptures. From James 5:16, “The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much” we learnt that we need to have a right relationship with God for our prayers to work! It is important to remove any hindrances to our prayers like sin, an unforgiving spirit, pride, doubt, and a love of the world. Delighting ourselves when we come into God’s presence and having right priorities also will ensure that our prayers will be answered.

Praying in unity is important for all believers. For married couples praying in unity is vital. How can God answer if the husband is praying for one thing, and the wife praying for the opposite! “... If two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven”(Matthew 18: 19).

Abiding in Christ is going to the source of the power of God. When we are abiding in Him, whatever we ask shall be done for us (John 15:7). When we ask God, He is glorified when He answers us. When we ask for big things, the glory for God will be big too.

Next, Brother Han Joke Kwang, who is the Coordinator of the Prayer Rally, shared snippets of God’s Word on drawing near



to God. He also disclosed how the Lord spoke and dealt with him as he drew near to God in prayer.

It is crucial for Calvary Church to pray if we are to impact the generations and transform lives. Every Calvarite has the authority in prayer when we pray in Jesus name. Han used the illustration of a motor vehicle to show the importance of depending on the Holy Spirit's power to pray effectively. The car engine is powerful and needs a key to start it. The Holy Spirit is like the key. We need Him to unleash the power of God. Frequent refuelling is required to run the car. The spiritual analogy is - "When you abide in God, the petrol station goes with you." The encouragement is to abide in Jesus and be empowered to pray.

This was followed with a time of praying for the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Praise God that 34 adults and children were filled with the Holy Spirit, with the evidence of speaking in tongues.

Associate Pastor Timothy Ong with church intercessors, Lina Lau, Peggy Low, Wong Yih Mun, James Wong and Veronice See led in corporate prayer for

the needs of all Calvarites, our pastors and leaders, the nation and churches in Malaysia.

PERLUMBAAN UNTUK KEMENANGAN

“Karena kita mempunyai banyak saksi, bagaikan awan yang mengelilingi kita, marilah kita menanggalkan semua beban dan dosa yang begitu merintangi kita, dan berlomba dengan tekun dalam perlombaan yang diwajibkan bagi kita. Marilah kita melakukannya dengan mata yang tertuju kepada Yesus, yang memimpin kita dalam iman, dan yang membawa iman kita itu kepada kesempurnaan, yang dengan mengabaikan kehinaan tekun memikul salib ganti sukacita yang disediakan bagi Dia, yang sekarang duduk di sebelah kanan takhta Tuhan” (Ibrani 12:1-2).

Penulis buku Ibrani menerangkan hidup untuk Kristus sebagai satu perlumbaan. Satu perlumbaan yang akan dimenangi oleh kehidupan yang dikehendaki oleh Tuhan. Seperti mana seorang atlet, orang-orang Kristian perlu berdisiplin untuk memenangi perlumbaan. Ia adalah satu disiplin yang memanggil kita untuk “mengenepikan setiap beban dan dosa yang begitu mudah merintangi kita.” Ia adalah satu perlumbaan yang perlu berlari dengan daya ketahanan, memandang kepada Yesus, yang adalah pengarang dan penamat iman kita, yang dengan contoh, “tekun memikul salib, mengabaikan kehinaan dan sekarang duduk di sebelah kanan takhta Tuhan”.

Sebagai dorongan, penulis Ibrani menyatakan bahawa terdapat sekumpulan besar saksi bersorak untuk kita, menunjukkan bahawa kita bukan sendirian. Ini adalah individu-individu



sebelum kita, yang telah bertanding dalam perlumbaan dengan kejayaan dan telah menang. Dalam pasal sebelas buku Ibrani, kita mendapati senarai beberapa daripada mereka.

- “**Karena iman Habel telah mempersembahkan kepada Tuhan korban yang lebih baik daripada korban Kain. Dengan jalan itu ia memperoleh kesaksian kepadanya, bahwa ia benar, karena Tuhan berkenanakan persembahannya itu dan karena iman ia masih berbicara, sesudah ia mati**” (Ibrani 11:4). Habel mentaati Tuhan dan Tuhan memberkati dia.
- “**Karena iman Henokh terangkat, supaya ia tidak mengalami kematian, dan ia tidak ditemukan, karena Tuhan telah mengangkatnya. Sebab sebelum ia terangkat, ia memperoleh kesaksian, bahwa ia berkenan akan kepada Tuhan**” (Ibrani 11:5). Dalam Kejadian 5:22, ia berkata, “**Henokh hidup bergaul dengan Tuhan selama tiga ratus tahun lagi.**” Adalah dikatakan bahawa Henokh berjalan begitu dekat dengan Tuhan oleh itu Tuhan berkata kepadanya, “**Oleh kerana kamu lebih dekat kepada rumahku daripada rumahmu, biarlah Aku membawamu pulang.**” Dan Tuhan membawa dia pulang.
- “**Karena iman, maka Nuh--dengan petunjuk Tuhan tentang sesuatu yang belum kelihatan--dengan taat**

mempersiapkan bahtera untuk menyelamatkan keluarganya; dan karena iman itu ia menghukum dunia, dan ia ditentukan untuk menerima kebenaran, sesuai dengan imannya” (Ibrani 11:7). Setiap kejahatan dosa berleluasa pada zaman Nuh. Hidup dalam dosa adalah kebiasaan dalam kehidupan. Tetapi Nuh mentaati Tuhan dan isi rumahnya diselamatkan daripada banjir.

- “**Dengan iman Abram mentaati apabila dia dipanggil untuk keluar ke tempat yang mana dia akan menerima sebagai warisan. Dan dia pun keluar, dengan tidak mengetahui di mana dia akan pergi**” (Ibrani 11:8).
- “**Karena iman ia juga dan Sara beroleh kekuatan untuk menurunkan anak cucu, walaupun usianya sudah lewat, karena ia menganggap Dia, yang memberikan janji itu setia**” (Ibrani 11:11).

Ibrani 11:32 berkata, “**Dan apakah lagi yang harus aku sebut? Sebab aku akan kekurangan waktu, apabila aku hendak menceritakan tentang Gideon, Barak, Simson, Yefta, Dauid dan Samuel dan para nabi**” (Ibrani 11:32). Terdapat lebih lagi saksi-saksi sebagaimana penulis Ibrani berkata, “sebuah awan besar saksi-saksi”. Awan besar saksi-saksi ini sedang bertumbuh dan jikalau Yesus tidak kembali dengan segera, nama kamu boleh ditambahkan ke dalam senarai.

Perlumbaan ini memerlukan disiplin dengan ketekunan. Disiplin ini adalah dua kali ganda. Pertama, merupakan disiplin mengeneipkan setiap beban. Kedua, mengeneipkan dosa-dosa yang begitu mudah merintanggi kita atau menyebabkan kita jatuh.

1. DISIPLIN YANG MENGENEIPKAN SETIAP BEBAN

Untuk diketepikan, bermakna untuk menanggalkan, melepaskan, untuk menghapuskan atau untuk mengeluarkan. Atlet-atlet memahami perkara ini. Sebagai contoh, sebelum mana-mana perlawanan tinju, peninju mendisiplinkan dirinya untuk mengurangkan berat badan yang berlebihan. Ini akan melayakkan mereka dengan berat badan yang tepat untuk menemui lawan mereka dan untuk mereka menjadi sesuai, lebih kuat dan dapat menentang pencabar mereka. Jadi, "mengeneipkan" adalah mengenai mendisiplinkan diri dengan ketekunan untuk menjadi cergas dan kuat untuk menjalani kehidupan Kristian apabila berhadapan dengan cabaran.

Beban mungkin bukanlah aktiviti yang berdosa dan salah. Ia mungkin perkara yang sah atau aktiviti yang tidak salah tetapi mereka tidak membantu untuk kamu dan boleh menjadi halangan. Ia adalah bagasi tambahan yang menghalang kamu daripada menjadi seorang pemenang. Sebagai contoh, menonton televisyen mungkin tidak salah. Tetapi jika kamu tidak berdisiplin dalam perkara ini, ia akan merompak masa tetap kamu untuk berdoa dan menyelidiki Alkitab. Penulis Ibrani mengatakan kita mesti mengeneipkan atau berhenti melakukan perkara-perkara yang menghalang dan dosa-dosa yang begitu mudah merintanggi kamu daripada menjadi berjaya dalam perlumbaan dengan menjadi kesaksian untuk Tuhan.

Yesus memberikan kita satu contoh yang baik mengenai pemerintah muda yang kaya. Yesus berkata kepadanya, "**Ketika orang muda itu mendengar perkataan itu, pergilah ia dengan sedih, sebab banyak hartanya**" (Matius 19:22). Perhatikan bahawa perkataan 'sempurna' di sini bermakna kamu bukannya apa yang sepatutnya kamu jadi, kamu mempunyai masalah "beban". Menjadi kaya bukannya dosa kerana terdapat banyak saksi yang disenaraikan dalam Ibrani 11 dikurniakan dengan harta benda yang lumayan. Tetapi Yesus sedang merujuk kepada isu keutamaan dalam kehidupan pemuda kaya ini. Dalam Matius 19:16-24, kita belajar bahawa soalan anak muda ini adalah, "perbuatan baik apakah yang harus ku perbuat untuk memperoleh hidup yang kekal?" "**Semuanya itu telah kuturuti, apa lagi yang masih kurang?**" (ayat 20). Ini

menunjukkan bahawa dia tidak hidup berdosa. Tetapi Tuhan bukanlah yang utama dalam kehidupannya! Dalam erti kata lain, Yesus telah mengundang dia untuk mengutamakan Tuhan dan berjalan dengan-Nya dan dia akan dapat mencari hidup yang kekal. Tetapi pemuda itu tidak ingin atau tidak dapat mengeneipkan "beban"nya iaitu hartanya (ayat 22).

Contoh lain, "Ketika Yesus dan murid-murid-Nya melanjutkan perjalanan mereka, berkatalah seorang di tengah jalan kepada Yesus: "Aku akan mengikut Engkau, ke mana saja Engkau pergi." Yesus berkata kepadanya: "**Serigala mempunyai liang dan burung mempunyai sarang, tetapi Anak Manusia tidak mempunyai tempat untuk meletakkan kepala-Nya**" (Lukas 9:57-58). Yesus bertanya kepadanya, jika kamu tidak mempunyai tempat seperti aku, masihkah kamu akan membuat komitmen untuk mengikutiku? Adakah kamu bersedia untuk membayar harga untuk kehidupan saleh? Yesus berkata kepada yang lain, "Ikutlah Aku!" Tetapi orang itu berkata: "**Izinkanlah aku pergi dahulu menguburkan bapaku**" (Lukas 9:59). Yesus menjawabnya, "**Biarlah orang mati menguburkan orang mati; tetapi engkau, pergilah dan beritakanlah Kerajaan Tuhan di mana-mana**" (Lukas 9:60). Ia adalah mudah untuk melepasi apa yang dimaksudkan oleh Yesus. Yesus tidak mengatakan bahawa menguburkan bapa kamu adalah salah. Begitu juga Dia bukan mengajar anak tidak menghormati ibubapanya! Isi yang dimaksudkan atau pengajaran adalah mengutamakan Tuhan dahulu daripada segala-galanya. Keutamaan yang salah boleh menjadi beban yang menghalang kamu daripada memenangi perlumbaan itu. Perlumbaan Kristian boleh dimenangi dengan mengeneipkan beban yang menghalang kita dan menyebabkan kita terjatuh dan kalah dalam perlumbaan itu.

2. DOSA-DOSA YANG MUDAH MENIMPA KITA

Dosa-dosa yang mudah menimpa kita adalah dosa-dosa yang menjerat kita atau ikatan yang mengawal kita. Satu contoh seperti dosa ini adalah mengata orang kerana kamu tidak mempunyai disiplin dalam mengawal lidahmu. Ini adalah apa yang Alkitab katakan mengenai lidah, "**Jikalau ada seorang menganggap dirinya beribadah, tetapi tidak mengekang**

lidahnya, ia menipu dirinya sendiri, maka sia-sialah ibadahnya" (Yakobus 1:26) dan "Lidah pun adalah api; ia merupakan suatu dunia kejahatan dan mengambil tempat di antara anggota-anggota tubuh kita sebagai sesuatu yang dapat menodai seluruh tubuh dan menyalakan roda kehidupan kita, sedang ia sendiri dinyalakan oleh api neraka" (Yakobus 3:6). Oleh itu, Paulus memberitahu orang-orang Kristian Efesus, "... yaitu bahwa kamu, berhubung dengan kehidupan kamu yang dahulu, harus menanggalkan manusia lama, yang menemui kebinasaannya oleh nafsunya yang menyesatkan" (Efesus 4:22). Kita mesti menanggalkan dan dibebaskan daripada semua tingkah laku yang tidak beriman dahulu iaitu sebelum kita diselamatkan. Kita mesti mendapatkan kebebasan untuk berjaya dalam perlumbaan Kristian. Yesus berkata, "... Berjaga-jagalah dan waspadalah terhadap segala ketamakan, sebab walaupun seorang berlimpah-limpah hartanya, hidupnya tidaklah tergantung dari pada kekayaannya itu" (Lukas 12:15). Kehidupan tidak terdiri daripada apa yang kamu miliki. Yohanes menulis dalam 1 Yohanes 2:15, "**Janganlah kamu mengasih dunia dan apa yang ada di dalamnya. Jikalau orang mengasih dunia, maka kasih akan Bapa tidak ada di dalam orang itu.**" Yesus memberi perintah kepada kita "Kasihilah Tuhan mu, dengan segenap hatimu dan dengan segenap jiwa mu dan dengan segenap akal budimu"... "Dan hukum yang kedua, yang sama dengan itu, ialah: Kasihilah sesama mu manusia seperti diri mu sendiri" (Matius 22:37; 39).

Sebagai atlet Kristian, marilah kita berlari untuk menang. Mari kita mengeneipkan setiap beban dan dosa yang begitu mudah menjerat kita. Marilah kita menunjukan mata kita kepada Yesus, yang adalah pengarang dan penamat imanmu. Hidupmu akan menjadi kesaksian bagi kemuliaan Tuhan!

赢得赛跑 (一)

「我们既有这许多的见证人，如同云彩围着我们，就当放下各样的重担，脱去容易缠累我们的罪，存心忍耐，奔那摆在我们前头的路程，仰望为我们信心创始成终的耶稣。他因那摆在前面的喜乐，就轻看羞辱，忍受了十字架的苦难，便坐在神宝座的右边」（来12:1-2）

希伯来书的作者描述为基督而活比作一场赛跑。要赢得赛跑是要靠过得神赞许的生活。像每一个运动员一样，基督徒必须遵守纪律才能赢得赛跑。它是一种训练叫我们要「放下各样的重担，脱去容易缠累我们的罪」。这是一场存心忍耐奔跑的路程，仰望我们信心创始成终的主耶稣，祂成为我们的榜样，「就轻看羞辱，忍受了十字架的苦难，便坐在神宝座的右边」。

作为鼓励，希伯来书的作者提到，我们有许多许多的见证人，如同云彩围着我们为我们喝彩，暗示著我们不是独自一人。这些都是在我们之前的人，他们已经成功地跑完赛程并获胜。在希伯来书十一章中，我们找到他们中的一些人的名字。

- 「亚伯因着信，献祭与神，比该隐所献的更美，因此便得了称义的见证，就是神指他礼物作的见证。他虽然死了，却因这信，仍旧说话」（来11:4）。亚伯顺服神，神就赐福给他。
- 「以诺因着信，被接去，不至于见死，『人也找不着他，因为神已经把他接去了』；只是他被接去以先，已经得了神喜悦他的明证」（来11:5）。在创5:22说道：「以诺与神同行三百年」。有人说，以诺如此亲密地与神同行，结果神对他说，「既然你更靠近我的住处，让我接你回家吧。」神就接他回家。
- 「挪亚因着信，既蒙神指示他未见的事，动了敬畏的心，预备了一只方舟，使他全家得救。因此就定了那世代的罪，自己也承受了那从信而来的义」（来11:7）。在挪亚的日子，罪的邪恶行为猖獗。活在罪中是正常的的生活方式。但挪亚听从神而使他全家得救免被洪水毁灭。
- 「亚伯拉罕因着信，蒙召的时候就遵命出去，往将来要得为业的地方去；出去的时候，还不知往哪里去」（来11:8）。
- 「因着信，连撒拉自己，虽然过了生育的岁数，还能怀孕，因她以为那应许她的是可信的」（来11:11）。

来11:32说道：「我又何必再说呢？若要一一细说，基甸、巴拉、参孙、耶弗他、大卫、撒母耳，和众先知的事，时候就不够了」（来11:32）。还有更多的证人如同希伯来书的作者所说：「如同云彩围着我们」。这如同云彩的见证人日益增长，如果耶稣没有很快就会再临，你的名字会被记入名单内。这场赛跑需要有纪律，并持之以恒。这纪律是双重的。首先，是放下各样的重担的

纪律。第二，是脱去容易缠累我们或使我们跌倒的罪。

1. 放下各样的重担的纪律

要放下，意思是说脱去，脱掉，脱下或除去。运动员明白这一点。举例来说，在任何拳击比赛前，拳击手很有纪律的锻炼自己减轻多余的体重。这将使他们以正确的重量符合资格面对他们的对手，并有强健的体格能够接受他们的挑战者。所以，「放下」是关于持之以恒有纪律地锻炼自己增强体质，当面对挑战时能过基督徒的生活。重担也许不是有罪或不好的活动。它们可能是合法的事物或是非常无害的活动，但它们无助于你而可能成为绊脚石。它们是额外的行李阻碍你成为一个胜利者。例如，看电视也许不是有错。但如果你是在这方面纪律性差，它剥夺了你有一个规律的祈祷时间和研读圣经的时间。希伯来书的作者说，我们必须放下或停止做那些阻拦你的事情和容易缠累你的罪，使你不能成功地跑完赛程成为神的见证。

耶稣给我们一个很好的例子是关于一个年轻富有的官。耶稣对他说：「你若愿意作完全人，可去变卖你所有的，分给穷人，就必有财宝在天上；你还要来跟从我」（太19:21）。需要注意的是「完全」这个词在这里是指你不是你应该所是的人，你有一个「重担」的问题。富有不是有罪因在希伯来书11章中列出的见证人都蒙神祝福拥有很多的产业。但耶稣指的是在这富有的年轻人的生活中的优先问题。在马太福音19:16-24中，我们得知这个年轻人的提问是，「我该做什么善事才能得永生？」他接着说，他从他少年时就遵守了这一切诫命（20节）。这表明，他并没有过着罪恶的生活。但神不是在他的生命中居首位！换句话说，耶稣邀请他让神居首位并与祂同行，那么他就会得到永生。但年轻人却不愿意或不能放下他的「重担」，这是他的财宝（22节）。

再如，「他们走路的时候，有一人对耶稣说：『你无论往哪里去，我要跟从你。』」耶稣说：『狐狸有洞，天空的飞鸟有窝，只是人子没有枕头的地方』（路9:57-58）。耶稣问他，如果你像我一样没有地方，你还会作出承诺跟从我吗？你是否准备好为过敬虔的生活付出代价？耶稣对另一个人说：「『跟从我来！』那人说：『主，容我先回去埋葬我的父亲』（路9:59）。耶稣回答他说：『任凭死人埋葬他们的死人，你只管去传扬神国的道』（路9:60）。我们容易误解耶稣想要指出的。耶稣不是说埋葬你的父亲是错的。祂也不是教儿子不尊重父母！该重点或教训是要把神放在首位超过一切。本末倒置可以成为阻碍你赢得赛跑的重担。藉著

放下阻碍我们和使我们失足以致在赛跑中失败的重担，我们可以赢得基督徒赛跑。

2. 容易缠累我们的罪

容易缠累我们的罪是那些缠住我们的罪或控制我们的捆绑。这种罪的一个例子就是说闲话。你说闲话因为你没有纪律控制你的舌头。圣经对于舌头如此说：「若有人自以为虔诚，却不勒住他的舌头，反欺哄自己的心，这人的虔诚是虚的」（雅1:26）。「舌头就是火，在我们百体中，舌头是个罪恶的世界，能污秽全身，也能把生命的轮子点起来，并且是从地狱里点着的」（雅3:6）。因此，保罗告诉以弗所的基督徒：「…就要脱去你们从前行为上的旧人，这旧人是因私欲的迷惑渐渐变坏的」（弗4:22）。我们要脱去，从一切我们得救之前的不敬虔行为中得释放。我们要寻求释放，在基督徒赛跑中成功得胜。耶稣说道：「…你们要谨慎自守，免去一切的贪心，因为人的生命不在乎家道丰富」（路12:15）。生命并不在乎你拥有的。约翰在约翰壹书2:15写道：「不要爱世界和世界上的事。人若爱世界，爱父的心就不在他里面了」（约壹2:15）。耶稣吩咐我们：「『你要尽心、尽性、尽意爱主—你的神』。…其次也相仿，『就是要爱人如己』（太22:37；39）。

作为一个基督徒运动员，让我们赢得赛跑。让我们放下各样的重担和脱去容易缠累我们的罪。让我们仰望为你们信心创始成终的耶稣。你的生活将是一个见证荣耀归给神！

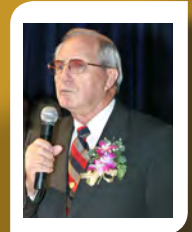
