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A MOTHER'S PAIN
A SON'S PRAYER



The first nine chapters of 1 Chronicles are full of names after names, for it is the record of the official family tree of Israel, beginning from Adam to Israel returned from captivity. Tucked in the midst of this list is a man named Jabez, whose life the historian thought worth mentioning. Two verses, 1 Chronicles 4:9-10, tells us his story.

The Bible says, “**Now Jabez was more honourable than his brothers, and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, ‘Because I bore him in pain.’** And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, ‘Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!’ So God granted him what he requested” (1 Chronicles 4:9-10).

A BRIEF PROFILE OF JABEZ

Jabez caused much, much pain to his mother when she gave birth to him. His mother perceived this son would be a pain all his life. So, she named him Jabez (which means pain), perhaps as a warning to all who would come to know him. At some point, Jabez must have got tired of being called “pain”. He did not want the stigma of pain nor did he want to cause pain. He decided to do something about it. He had a good attitude, he did not blame his mother or anyone. He turned from anger, self-pity and prayed a simple heart-cry prayer to the Lord.

LET US LEARN FROM JABEZ'S PRAYER

Jabez's prayer was simple yet profound, powerful and complete, a prayer that turned his life around, from one who would be a pain to one who

was more honourable. What began as a “curse was turned to a blessing.”

WHAT WAS JABEZ PRAYER?

1. Jabez simply asked God to bless him.

He prayed, “Bless me, indeed!”. At first glance it seemed to be a self-centred prayer, “Bless me!” But it was a cry of desperation, a recognition that unless God blessed him, he was doomed to be a failure. We need to first be blessed before we can be a blessing. When we are blessed by God, we will not be self-centred because we recognise His blessings, we will in turn be a blessing as God's blessings flow out of our lives.

What does bless mean?

a. To bless in the biblical sense means to ask God for impartation for supernatural favour. When you say, “God bless you”, it is a good impartation for others. But you can ask God to bless you too. He is able to do for you far beyond what anybody else can! The Bible says, “**The Lord's blessing is the greatest wealth. All our work adds nothing to it**” (Proverbs 10:22 TLB). The NKJV says, “The blessings of the Lord makes one rich and He adds no sorrow to it.” Every believer can pray for God's blessings. The Bible says, “**Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every (all) spiritual blessings in Christ**” (Ephesians 1:3). God's blessings are for every believer. There is no limitation to God's bountiful favour. We serve a God who is “.. abounding in goodness and truth” (Exodus 34:6).

b. This supernatural or divine favour

enables us to rise above all circumstances and challenges. When you pray, “Bless me”, God blesses you and puts you in a position of influence, not for you to enjoy but to be a blessing. Blessed people live challenging lives.

Some biblical examples

- Esther, a young Jewish girl was made Queen of Persia because of God's hand upon her (Esther 2:9). The blessing was not for her to enjoy. God had a purpose for her, to deliver her people (the Jews) from being destroyed. With the blessing, came the challenge. Esther rose to the challenge. She declared, “**If I perish, I perish**” (Esther 4:16). She did not perish, and saved her people from annihilation.
- Joseph was a young man who had to go through challenges beyond one's imaginations, because of God's dream, purpose and plan for his life. Ultimately, God brought him through all the trials victoriously (Genesis 50:20). The favour of God was upon Joseph. He was a blessed man in prison and in the palace.
- Mary, the mother of Jesus was blessed. The Bible described her as “**Highly favoured one ... blessed are you among women!**” (Luke 1:28). Another translation says, “**You are most blessed**”. Mary paid a great price and suffered much pain, both emotional and physical to be the mother of God's son, Jesus!
- When God is with you, you come out a winner or victorious in spite of the challenges.
- c. In asking God to bless him, Jabez left it entirely to God as how he

should be blessed. He simply prayed, "Bless me ..." Full Stop. Period. Jabez did not tell God how he needed to be blessed. He trusted completely in God's intention for him. Jabez's focus was, "I only want what God wants for me, nothing less, nothing more!". Trust God and be assured that however God blesses you, it would be for your best.

"My Testimony - How God Blessed My Life

I accepted Christ and was born again at age 15, the first in my Taoist family. In my youth, I was weak physically and fell sick often. My father called me "mosquito voice" because I had such a soft voice! I was timid and fearful in school. Thank God, my sister who is two years older, protected me from bullies in school. This sister whom everyone of us look up to, told me that I am the most blessed amongst the nine siblings (I am the sixth child) in our family. I am not the richest nor the most successful in terms of position, by secular standards, and yet my siblings say I am most blessed because they have seen the hand of God on my life, since I gave my life to Jesus from young and became a pastor. Every time there was a family challenge, when mother was alive, they would call me for help. They recognised that God had the answers to their challenges. I don't have the answer, but they recognised my God can help them."

2. Jabez asked God to enlarge his territory

Jabez was not asking for more real estate. He recognised there was more in store for him. Enlarge is another word for bless. Jabez was saying, "Lord, everything you have given me

and put under my care, take it and bless it (enlarge)." Enlarge is to reach the maximum or full potential, to excel, to multiply and to make room for growth and expansion.

Ask God to enlarge your "territory", your influence. All believers can influence others. For example spiritual mothers are a great influence and young people also can be an influence. The Bible says, "**Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity**" (1 Timothy 4:12). In my youth I lived a full life in Christ and through that life, I could impact lives. In my old age, I too can impact others because of the Christ life in me. God can help us maximise our influence, wherever He places us, in our home, school or market place, irrespective of how young or old we are!

Ask God to enlarge your family, your business and the labour of your hands. Family-wise, enlarge does not necessarily mean more (quantity) but can mean enrich (quality). Key family relationships are vital and when your relationships are right and prosper in every way, you can be a greater influence. Enlarge your vision and see as God sees.

3. Jabez asked for God's Hand to be upon him.

Jabez prayed in faith, believing he would receive blessings beyond his expectations when God blessed him and enlarged his territory. He envisaged that he would be stretched and could be overwhelmed. Thus, he prayed for God's hand to be upon him. The hand of the Lord is a biblical term for God's protection, power and presence in the life of his people. When God's hand is upon your life,

people notice you are different, you are a testimony. The Bible says, "**that all the peoples of the earth may know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever**" (Joshua 4:24). Prophet Isaiah says, "**Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear**" (Isaiah 59:1). When you are down and disappointed, you may find difficulty reaching Him. No matter how far you are from God, His hand is never too short to reach you. It is your iniquity that separated you from Him. All you have to do is to come back to Him.

4. Jabez asked God to keep him from evil. When you live the blessed life and the "larger" you become, evil and evil forces will try and hurt you. The world today is becoming more evil. Do not fear nor be overwhelmed. We walk through trials but we do not have to walk through evil, because we can pray that we be kept from evil. Jesus prayed for all believers, "**You should keep them from the evil one**" (John 17:15). He taught His disciples to pray, "**Deliver us from the evil one**" (Matthew 6:13).

Whatever situation you may be in, do not accept it nor dwell there. Turn to God. Trust Him absolutely. Pray. What He did for Jabez, He can do for you. God hears and answers prayer. Prayer can change your destiny. The Bible says, "**The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much**" (James 5:16).





Why is Easter important?



一个母亲的痛苦 一个儿子的祷告

《历代志上》前九章全是人的名字，因为它是以色列的官方家谱的记载，从亚当开始一直到以色列从被掳回来。藏在这个名单之中是一个叫雅比斯的人，历史学家认为他的生命值得一提。代上4: 9-10，这两节的经文告诉我们他的故事。

圣经上说道：「雅比斯比他众兄弟更尊贵，他母亲给他起名叫雅比斯，意思说：“我生他甚是痛苦。”雅比斯求告以色列的神说：

“甚愿你赐福与我，扩张我的疆界，你的手常与我同在，保佑我不遭患难，不受艰苦。”神就应允他所求的（代上4: 9-10）。

雅比斯的简介

雅比斯给他的母亲带来许多的痛苦，因为在生他的时候非常痛苦。他的母亲认为这儿子将是一辈子成为痛苦。于是，她给他取名雅比斯（意思是痛苦），或许作为所有将会认识他人的一个警告。在某些时候，雅比斯肯定是对被称为「痛苦」。他不要痛苦的耻辱，他也不希望引起痛苦。他决定做一些事情来改变这个情况。他有一个良好的态度，他并没有责怪他的母亲或任何人。他从愤怒，自怜转过来作了一个简单的祈祷从心里向耶和华求告。

让我们向雅比斯的祷告学习

雅比斯的祷告简单而又深刻，有能力完整，它扭转了他的一生，从将是一个痛苦的人生变为一个更尊贵的人生。把开始时是“一个诅咒变成一个祝福”。

雅比斯求告了什么？

I. 雅比斯祈求神赐福与他。

他求告说：「甚愿你赐福与我！」乍看之下，这似乎是一个以自我为中心的祷告，「赐福与我！」但它是一个绝望的呼求，认识到除非神赐福与他，他就注定是失败。我们首先需要先蒙福，我们才可以成为祝福。当我们蒙神祝福时，我们不会以自我为中心，因为我们认识到他的祝福，因着神的祝福流出我们的生命，我们将转而成为他人的祝福。

赐福意味着什么？

a. 赐福在圣经中的意思是祈求神赐下超自然的恩宠。当你说：「愿神赐福与你」，这是为他人好求神赐下恩宠。但是你也可以祈求神赐福与你。他能为你做的远远超出其他人能做的！圣经上说道：「耶和华所赐的是最大的财富。我们一切所做的不能加上什么」（箴10: 22，另一译本）。

「耶和华所赐的福使人富足，并不加上忧虑」。每一个信徒都能祈求神的赐福。圣经上说道：「愿颂赞归给我们主耶稣基督的父神。他在基督里曾把天上各样属灵的福气赐给我们」（弗1: 3）。神赐的福是给每一个信徒。神丰富的恩宠是没有限制。我们所事奉的神是「...有丰盛的慈爱和信实」的神（出34: 6）。

b. 这种超自然或神圣的恩宠，使我们能够超越所有的情况和挑战。当你祈祷：「赐福与我」，神就赐福与你并安置你在一个有

影响力的地位，不是让你享受，而是要成为一个祝福。有福的人是过著充满挑战的生活。

一些圣经的例子

• 以斯帖是一个犹太女子，她被立为波斯王后，因为神的手在她的身上（斯2: 9）。这祝福不是让她享受。神是有一个目的给她，为要拯救她的同胞（犹太人）脱离仇敌的杀戮。随着祝福，带来了挑战。以斯帖挺身迎接挑战。她宣告说：「我若死就死吧」（斯4: 16）。她没有死，而救了犹太同胞脱离灭族的危机。

• 约瑟是一名年轻人，他必须经过许多难以置信的挑战，因为神为他生命的梦想，目的和计划。最终，神给他带来胜利，通过所有的试炼（创50:20）。神的恩宠临在约瑟身上。在监狱或是在宫殿中，他都是一个有福的人。

• 耶稣的母亲马利亚是蒙福的人。圣经上描述她为「蒙大恩的女子...在众女子中是蒙福的」（路1: 28）。另一个译本说道：「你是最有福的人」。作为耶稣，神的儿子的母亲，马利亚付出极大的代价，心灵和身体受到许多的痛苦！

当神与你同在，你最终是一个胜利者或得胜者，尽管面临的挑战。

c. 在祈求神赐福与他，雅比斯把他应该如何得到赐福这事完全交托给神。他只是求告，「赐福与我...」句点。句号。雅比斯没有告诉神他如何需要得到赐福。他完全信任神对他的心意。雅比斯的焦点是，「我只想要神要给我的，不多也不少！」信靠神和放心，无论神如何赐福与你，这将是对你最好的。

我的见证—神如何赐福与我的生命

我在15岁时接受了基督并得重生，在我信奉道教家里是第一个信主的人。在我年轻的时候，我身体很虚弱，经常生病。我父亲叫我“蚊声”，因为我有一个柔弱的声音！

在学校我是胆怯和感到害怕。感谢神，比我大两岁的姐姐，保护我免受同学的欺负。这位我们兄弟姐妹所尊敬的姐姐，她告诉我，在我们家里的九位兄弟姐妹之中我是最幸福的一位（我是排行第六的孩子）。在地位上，按世俗的标准，我不是最富有，也不是最成功，然而我的兄弟姐妹说我是最有福的，因为他们已经看到神的手在我的生命中，自从我年轻时起信靠耶稣并成为牧师。当母亲活着的时候，每一次在面对家庭挑战时，他们都会叫我帮忙。他们认识到，神有办法应对他们的挑战。我没有答案，但他们认识到我的神能帮助他们。

II. 雅比斯求告神扩张他的疆界

雅比斯不是要求更多的房地产。他知道到神有许多福要赐给他。扩张是赐福的另一个词。雅比斯说：「主啊，一切你所赐给我的和

托付我照顾的，求你悦纳它和赐福它（扩张）」。扩张是达到最大或发挥全潜力，有优越表现，倍增和扩充成长和扩展的空间。

求神扩张你的「境界」，你的影响力。所有的信徒可以影响他人。例如属灵的母亲有一个很大的影响力和年轻人也可以是一个影响力。圣经上说道：「不可叫人小看你年轻，总要在言语、行为、爱心、信心、清洁上，都作信徒的榜样」（提前4: 12）。我年轻时在基督里过着一个充实的生命，并通过这生命，我能影响他人的生命。在我年老的时候，我也可以发挥影响力，因为有基督的生命在我里面。神能帮助我们充分地发挥我们的影响力，无论他安排我们在哪里，在我们的家里，学校或职场，不论我们是多么年轻还是年长！

求神扩张你的家庭，你的事业和你双手作的劳力。从家庭的角度来看，扩张并不一定意味着更多（数量），而是意味着丰富和兴盛。关键家庭关系是至关重要的，当你的关系是正确的，并在各方面亨通时，你就可以有更大的影响力。扩大你的视野并看到神所看到的。

III. 雅比斯求神的手临到他身上

雅比斯凭信心祷告，相信当神赐福与他和扩张他的疆界时，他会领受超出他所期望的祝福。他料想他会被伸展，可能会不堪重负。于是，他祈求神的手临在他身上。神的手是神在他的子民生命中的保护，力量和同在的圣经词语。当神的手临到你的生命中，人们会注意到你是不同的，你是一个见证。圣经上说道：「要使地上万民都知道，耶和华的手大有能力，也要使你们天天敬畏耶和华—你们的神」（书4: 24）。先知以赛亚说道：「看哪，耶和华的膀臂并非过短，不能拯救，耳朵并非发沉，不能听见」（赛59: 1）。当你气馁，失望时，你可能会发现很难亲近他。不管你是离开神有多远或跌倒，他向你伸出的手是永远不会太短，他能拯救你。这是你的罪孽使你与他隔绝。你所要做的，就是要回到他的面前。

IV. 雅比斯求神保佑他不遭患难

当你过着蒙福的生活和你成为「更大」时，邪恶和邪恶的势力会尝试伤害你。当今世界正变得更邪恶。不要惧怕，也不要被压倒。我们经过试炼，但我们不必经过邪恶。因为我们可以祈求神保守我们脱离邪恶。耶稣为所有的信徒祈祷：「求你保全他们，使他们脱离那恶者」（约17: 15）。他教导他的门徒祷告：「救我们脱离那恶者」（太6: 13）。

无论你遭遇的情况是怎么样，不要接受它，也不要停留在那里。转向神。完全的依靠他。祷告。他为雅比斯做的事，他也能为你做。神垂听和应允祷告。祷告可以改变你的命运。圣经上说道：「义人祈祷所发的力量是大有功效的」（雅5: 16）。

Sembilan fasal pertama dalam 1 Tawarikh adalah penuh dengan nama, kerana ia adalah catatan rasmi tentang asal usul keluarga Israel, bermula dengan Adam kepada Israel kembali dari tawanan. Tersirat antara semua ini adalah seorang lelaki bernama Yabes, yang mana kehidupannya dianggap oleh pengarang penting untuk disebutkan. Dua ayat, 1 Tawarikh 4:9-10 menceritakan kepada kita tentangnya.

Alkitab berkata, **"Yabes lebih dimuliakan dari pada saudara-saudaranya; nama Yabes itu diberi ibunya kapadanya sebab katanya: "Aku telah melahirkan dia dengan kesakitan."** Yabes berseru kepada Tuhan Israel, katanya: **"Kiranya Engkau memberkati aku berlimpah-limpah dan memperluas daerahku, dan kiranya tangan-Mu menyertai aku, dan melindungi aku dari pada malapetaka, sehingga kesakitan tidak menimpa aku!"** Dan Tuhan mengabulkan permintaannya itu" (1 Tawarikh 4: 9-10).

PROFIL SEIMBAS MENGENAI YABES

Yabes menyebabkan banyak kesakitan kepada ibunya apabila beliau melahirkannya. Ibunya menganggap ini sebagai tanda anaknya akan membawa kesakitan sepanjang kehidupannya. Jadi, ia menamakannya, Yabes (yang bermakna kesakitan), mungkin sebagai satu amaran kepada mereka yang akan mengenalinya. Pada satu tahap, Yabes sudah letih mendengar panggilan namanya "kesakitan". Ia tidak mahu stigma kesakitan dan juga tidak mahu menyebabkan kesakitan. Jadi ia memutus untuk melakukan sesuatu tentangnya. Ia mempunyai sikap yang baik, tidak menuduh ibunya atau sesiapapun. Ia berpaling dari kemarahan, rasa kasihan diri-sendiri dan menujukan doa ringkas dari hatinya kepada Tuhan

kesakitan kepada seorang yang lebih dihormati. Apa yang bermula sebagai satu "kutukan" bertukar menjadi satu "berkat".

APA YANG DIDOA AKAN OLEH YABES?

1. Yabes hanya meminta Tuhan untuk memberkatiinya.

Ia berdoa, "Berkati aku berlimpah-limpah!" Pada mulanya, nampaknya, itu merupakan satu doa yang berpusat pada diri-sendiri, "Berkati akul!" Tetapi ia merupakan satu tangisan yang terdesak, satu pengakuan bahawa melainkan Tuhan memberkatiinya, ia ditakdirkan gagal. Kita perlu mula-mula diberkati sebelum kita boleh menjadi saluran berkat. Apabila kita diberkati Tuhan, kita tidak akan mementingkan diri sendiri kerana kita akui berkatNya, dan seterusnya kita akan menjadi berkat apabila berkat Tuhan dicurahkan dari kehidupan kita. Apakah erti diberkati?

a. Diberkati dalam Alkitab bererti meminta Tuhan untuk mencurahkan berkat luarbiasa.

Apabila kamu berkata, "Tuhan berkati kamu", ianya adalah satu pencurahan yang baik kepada orang lain. Tetapi kamu juga boleh meminta Tuhan untuk memberkati kamu juga. Ia boleh dilakukan bagi kamu jauh melebihi daripada sesiapapun! Alkitab berkata, **"Berkat Tuhanlah yang menjadikan kaya, susah payah tidak akan menambahinya"** (Amsal 10:22). Setiap umat Kristian boleh berdoa untuk berkat Tuhan. Alkitab berkata, **"Terpuji Tuhan dan Bapa Tuhan kita Yesus Kristus yang dalam Kristus telah mengaruniakan kepada kita segala berkat rohani di dalam sorga"** (Efesus 1:3). Berkat Tuhan adalah untuk semua orang percaya. Tidak ada batasnya kasih karuniaNya yang berkelimpahan. Kita melayani Tuhan yang **"...berlimpah kasihNya dan setiaNya"** (Keluaran 34:6).

b. Berkat luarbiasa dari Tuhan ini membolehkan kita bangkit atas

setiap situasi dan cabaran. Apabila kamu berdoa, "Berkati aku", Tuhan memberkati kamu dan meletakkan kamu dalam satu posisi berpengaruh, bukannya untuk kamu nikmati tetapi untuk kamu menjadi satu berkat. Orang yang diberkati hidup dengan kehidupan yang mencabar.

Beberapa contoh Alkitabiah

- Ester, seorang wanita Yahudi dijadikan Permaisuri Persia kerana tangan Tuhan menyertainya (Ester 2:9). Berkat itu bukannya untuk dinikmati oleh dirinya. Tuhan ada rencana baginya, untuk membebaskan baninya (umat Yahudi) dari dibinasakan. Dengan berkat itu, datanglah cabaran. Ester bangkit menghadapi cabaran itu. Dia mengistiharkan, **"kalau terpaksa aku mati, biarlah aku mati"** (Ester 4:16). Ia tidak mati, dan menyelamatkan baninya daripada kemusnahan.
- Yusuf merupakan seorang anak muda yang terpaksa mengharungi banyak cabaran yang begitu besar sekali, oleh kerana impian, rencana dan tujuan Tuhan dalam hidupnya. Pada akhirnya, Tuhan membawa ia melalui semua cabaran itu dengan kemenangan (Kejadian 50:20). Berkat Tuhan ada pada Yusuf. Ia diberkati sama ada di penjara maupun di istana.
- Maria, ibu Yesus diberkati. Alkitab menggambarkannya sebagai **"Yang dikaruniai"** (Lukas 1:28). **Satu terjemahan lain ialah, "Engkau sungguh diberkati"**. Maria membayar harga yang tinggi dan menanggung banyak kesakitan, secara emosi dan fizikal untuk menjadi ibu kepada anak Tuhan, Yesus!
- Dalam meminta Tuhan untuk memberkatiinya, Yabes membiarkan Tuhan memutuskan bagaimana untuk memberkatiinya.

MARI KITA PELAJARI DARI DOA YABES

Doa Yabes adalah ringkas namun mendalam, berkuasa dan sempurna, satu doa yang mengubah hidupnya, daripada seorang yang merupakan

KESAKITAN SEORANG IBU DOA SEORANG ANAK

Dia hanya berdoa, “Berkati aku ...” Itu saja. Yabes tidak beritahu Tuhan bagaimana ia perlu diberkati. Ia percayakan kehendak Tuhan dengan sepenuhnya. Tumpuan Yabes ialah, “Saya hanya mahukan apa yang Tuhan mahukan untuk saya, tidak kurang, tidak lebih!”. Percayalah kepada Tuhan dan biarlah kamu dijaminkan bahawa bagaimana Tuhan memberkati kamu, Itulah yang terbaik.

Kesaksian Saya – Bagaimana Tuhan Memberkati Hidup Saya

Saya menerima Kristus dan lahir baru pada umur 15 tahun, orang pertama dalam keluarga yang beragama Tao. Apabila saya masih muda, saya merupakan seorang yang lemah secara fizikal dan selalu jatuh sakit. Bapa saya memanggil saya “suara nyamuk” kerana saya mempunyai suara yang begitu halus! Saya merupakan seorang yang penakut dalam sekolah. Syukur pada Tuhan kakak saya yang berumur dua tahun lebih tua daripada saya melindungi saya dari pembuli-pembuli di sekolah. Kakak ini yang dipandang tinggi oleh semua orang memberitahu saya bahawa sayalah yang paling diberkati antara sembilan adik beradik (saya anak keenam) dalam keluarga kami. Saya bukanlah yang terkaya ataupun yang paling sukses dalam kedudukan menurut standard dunia, dan namun begitu adik beradik saya mengatakan saya yang paling diberkati kerana mereka telah melihat tangan Tuhan atas kehidupan saya, semenjak saya memberikan hidup saya kepada Yesus sejak kecil dan menjadi seorang pendita. Setiap kali ada cabaran dalam keluarga, apabila ibu saya masih hidup, mereka akan menghubungi saya. Mereka akui Tuhan ada jawapan kepada masalah mereka. Saya tidak ada jawapannya, tetapi mereka akui Tuhan saya boleh membantu mereka.

2. Yabes meminta Tuhan untuk memperluaskan daerahnya

Yabes bukannya meminta ladang tanah yang luas. Ia mengakui ada banyak lagi untuknya. Memperluaskan adalah kata lain untuk berkat. Yabes

mengatakan, “Tuhan, segala yang engku berikan padaku dan dibawah jagaanku, ambillah dan berkatilahnya (perluaskan)”. Perluaskan adalah untuk mencapai maksima atau potensi penuh, untuk berjaya, untuk berlipat ganda dan mempunyai ruang untuk pertumbuhan dan perluasan. Minta Tuhan untuk memperluaskan “wilayah” kamu, pengaruh kamu. Semua umat Kristian boleh mempengaruhi orang lain. Sebagai contoh, ibu rohani adalah pengaruh besar dan orang muda juga boleh menjadi orang yang berpengaruh. Alkitab mengatakan, **“Jangan seorangpun menganggap engkau rendah karena engkau muda. Jadilah teladan bagi orang-orang percaya, dalam perkataanmu, dalam tingkah lakumu, dalam kasihmu, dalam kesetiaanmu dan dalam kesucianmu”** (1 Timotius 4:12). Apabila saya masih muda, saya hidup penuh dalam Kristus dan melalui hidup itu, saya boleh mengimpak hidup orang lain. Dalam umur saya yang lebih tua ini juga, saya boleh membawa kesan kepada orang lain oleh kerana kehidupan Kristus dalam diri saya. Tuhan boleh membantu kita memaksimumkan pengaruh, dimana la menempatkan kita, dirumah, sekolah atau tempat kerja, tidak kira kita muda atau tua!

Minta Tuhan untuk memperluaskan keluarga kamu, perniagaan kamu dan usaha tangan kamu. Dalam keluarga, perluas tidak semestinya bermakna penggandaan dalam kuantiti tetapi boleh bermakna diperkayakan dan diberkati. Kunci perhubungan keluarga adalah penting dan apabila perhubungan kamu betul dan diberkati, kamu boleh menjadi lebih berpengaruh. Perluaskan visi kamu dan lihat dari sudut Tuhan.

3. Yabes meminta tangan Tuhan untuk menyertainya

Yabes berdoa dengan iman, percaya bahawa ia akan diberkati menjangkau apa yang diharapkan apabila Tuhan memberkatinya dan memperluaskan wilayahnya. Ia menjangkakan bahawa ia akan di perluaskan dan mungkin akan ditenggelami. Maka itu, ia berdoa untuk tangan Tuhan atasnya. Tangan Tuhan adalah satu jenis ayat

Alkitabiah untuk perlindungan, kuasa dan hadirat Tuhan dalam kehidupan umatNya. Apabila tangan Tuhan menyertai kamu, orang akan sedar bahwa kamu berbeza, kamu adalah satu saksi. Alkitab berkata, **“supaya semua bangsa di bumi tahu, bahwa kuat tangan TUHAN, dan supaya mereka selalu takut kepada TUHAN, Tuhanmu”** (Yosua 4:24). Nabi Yesaya berkata, **“Sesungguhnya, tangan TUHAN tidak kurang panjang untuk menyelamatkan, dan pendengaran- Nya tidak kurang tajam untuk mendengar”** (Yesaya 59:1). Apabila kamu berasa kecewa, kamu akan dapat sukar untuk menjangkauNya. Tidak kira sama ada kamu jauh dari Tuhan atau sudah jatuh, tanganNya tidak terlalu pendek untuk menjangkau kamu. Dosa kamulah yang memisahkan kamu dariNya. Apa yang kamu boleh lakukan ialah untuk kembali kepadaNya.

4. Yabes meminta Tuhan untuk melindunginya daripada malapetaka

Apabila kamu hidup diberkati dan semakin “besarnya” kamu, kejahanatan akan cuba menyakiti kamu. Dunia sekarang menjadi semakin jahat. Jangan takut dan ditenggelami. Kita melalui pencobaan tetapi tidak perlu melalui kejahanatan kerana kita boleh berdoa agar dilindungi dari kejahanatan. Yesus berdoa untuk semua umatNya, **“Engkau melindungi mereka dari pada yang jahat”** (Yohanes 17:15). Ia mengajar pengikutNya untuk berdoa, **“Lepaskanlah kami dari pada yang jahat”** (Matius 6:13).

Apapun situasi kamu, janganlah terimanya atau menetap dalamnya. Berpaling kepada Tuhan. Percayalah kepadaNya dengan sepenuhnya. Berdoa. Apa yang la lakukan untuk Yabes, la boleh lakukannya untuk kamu. Tuhan mendengar dan menjawab doa kamu. Doa dapat mengubah masa depan kamu. Alkitab berkata, **“Doa orang yang benar, bila dengan yakin didoakan, sangat besar kuasanya”** (Yakobus 5:16).




