THE SECOND ADAM — JESUS CHRIST

The Scriptures tells us,
"The first man, Adam
became a living person.
But the last Adam –
that is, Christ – is a life-giving
Spirit. Adam, the first man,
was made from the dust
of the earth, while Christ,
the second man, came from
heaven. Earthly people are
like the earthly man,
and heavenly people are
like the heavenly man."
(1 Corinthians 15:45, 47-48).

The first Adam failed to be the man he was created to be. The Bible says, God created man to be a living soul, but man sinned by disobedience. To sin is to miss the mark. The penalty of sin is death. The world defines the first Adam by his physique, his strength, his material success and his status in society. The Bible describes the first Adam as wretched and perishing, "And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't. I want to do

what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death?" (Romans 7:18-20, 24). The first Adam, because of his sinful nature is incapable of being a righteous man, pleasing to God. This man has life but lives by his carnal nature that leads to death even though he may have a form of godliness (2 Timothy 3:5).

The Bible compares the first man with Jesus Christ, the Second Adam, who came to redeem us. The Bible says, "Do not let sin control the way you live; and do not give in to sinful desires. Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. Instead, give yourselves completely to God, for you were dead, but now you have new life. So use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God. Sin is no longer your master, for you no longer live under the requirements of the law. Instead, you live under the freedom of God's grace" (Romans 6:12-14). Those who are redeemed in Christ live the life God intended for them to live, living a positive and victorious life over their sinful nature and is pleasing to God.

Every man must decide who he belongs to, whether to the first Adam, who lives a sinful carnal lifestyle or the Second Adam, Jesus Christ, who has redeemed us from sin and death and lives by God's grace through faith, a righteous life pleasing to God (Ephesians 2:8). The Bible gives us the differences between the first Adam and Second Adam.

1. THE REDEEMED MAN ACCEPTS HIS RESPONSIBILITY TO LIVE THE LIFE GOD INTENDED FOR HIM

The Bible gives us the account of the fall of the first man, Adam, "The Lord God placed the man in the Garden of Eden to tend and watch



over it. But the Lord God warned him, "You may freely eat the fruit of every tree in the garden - except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat its fruit, you are sure to die"" (Genesis 2:15-17). "The serpent was the shrewdest of all the wild animals the Lord God had made. One day he asked the woman, "Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?" "Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden," the woman replied. "It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we are not allowed to eat. God said, 'You must not eat it or even touch it; if you do, you will die." "You won't die!" the serpent replied to the woman. "God knows that your eyes will be opened as soon as you eat it, and you will be like God, knowing both good and evil." The woman was convinced. She saw that the tree was beautiful and its fruit looked delicious, and she wanted the wisdom it would give her. So she took some of the fruit and ate it. Then she gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it, too" (Genesis 3:1-6). Such temptations are common to man today, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life. The first Adam failed to take responsibility and reject passivity in his role as a man and a husband. Adam failed in his responsibility to protect and support his wife at her time of need by exercising his God-given headship and leadership but chose to follow her in disobedience.

In contrast, the Second Adam, Jesus Christ, when tempted in the wilderness (Luke 4:1-13), He responded with the Word of God. Men in Christ know the Word of God and do the will of God. They understand their role and know their responsibilities. They are called to be the priest of their household, to know and teach the Word of God (1 Peter 2:9). They are to love, protect and provide for their families.

Paul says to those who are in Christ Jesus, "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross" (Philippians 2:5-8 NKJV). Men who are in Christ are not passive to social and spiritual depravity but accept their responsibilities in living the life that God intended for them.

2. THE REDEEMED MAN IS A LEADER AND IS COURAGEOUS


The Bible says, "But I want you to know that the head of every man is Christ, the head of woman is man, and the head of Christ is God" (1 Corinthians 11:3 NKJV). Men are created to take leadership with courage. The first man Adam failed to be a courageous leader and the

head of his family when tempted. Instead, he allowed his wife to lead in what was specifically his role that resulted in the fall of the human race.

The Second Adam, Jesus Christ is our example (Luke 4:1-13):

- Jesus proved to be master over His passion when He refused to give in to the lust of the flesh when Satan requested Him to turn the stones to bread, since He was the Son of God, and the pride of life, when He was tempted to be given the kingdoms of this world if He would worship Satan.
- Jesus knew the Word of God. He said, "Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve" (Luke 4:8 NKJV).
 Jesus had the courage to confront Satan and not surrender like the first Adam.
- Jesus was humble. He came to serve. Jesus said, "You shall not tempt the Lord your God... and Him only you shall serve" (Luke 4:12, 8b NKJV).

Men's responsibility is not merely to be the breadwinner of the family but to be a priest in



his home, a prophet of God to proclaim God's Word and a king to rule godly in his home when a crisis takes place (Revelation 1:6). He is to teach the Word of God and give direction to his family, being a leader and head of the family to provide confidence and safety.

3. THE REDEEMED MAN LOOKS FORWARD WITH JOY TO HIS REWARD

God designed manhood to be liberating and rewarding. The responsibility of a man was never intended to be burdensome. Men in Christ do the will of God with joy. The Bible says, "Therefore, we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnared us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God" (Hebrews 12:1-2 NKJV). Doing the will of God gives us vision, purpose and fulfilment in life. The call to man as God intended is more than just carrying out responsibilities and making sacrifices. It is in principle a call to a life of freedom to live, love and serve God and our neighbour. Satan succeeded in deceiving the first Adam that rob God's intended purpose for man to be real men after the Second Adam, Jesus Christ. However, the responsibility and choice lie with each one of us.

Let us choose to be God's intended men after the Second Adam, Jesus Christ, to live as victors over the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye and the pride of life. The Bible says, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13 NKJV).

ADAM KEDUA — YESUS KRISTUS

Alkitab memberitahu kita,
"...Manusia pertama, Adam menjadi makhluk yang hidup", tetapi Adam yang akhir – iaitu, Kristus adalah roh yang menghidupkan. Adam, manusia pertama berasal dari debu tanah dan bersifat jasmani, sementara Kristus, manusia kedua berasal dari sorga. Makhluk-makhluk alamiah sama dengan dia yang berasal dari debu tanah dan makhluk-makhluk sorgawi sama dengan Dia yang berasal dari sorga (1 Korintus 15:45, 47-48).

Adam pertama gagal untuk menjadi manusia yang direncanakan dari ciptaan Tuhan. Alkitab berkata, Tuhan mencipta manusia untuk menjad satu jiwa yang hidup, tetapi manusia berdosa kerana ketidaktaatannya. Berdosa bermakna pelanggaran. Hukuman dosa adalah maut. Dunia mendefinisikan Adam pertama dengan fisiknya, kekuatannya, kejayaan kebendaannya dan statusnya di masyarakat. Alkitab menggambarkan Adam pertama sebagai orang yang celaka dan binasa, "Sebab aku tahu, bahwa di dalam aku, yaitu di dalam aku sebagai manusia, tidak ada sesuatu yang baik. Sebab kehendak memang ada di dalam aku, tetapi bukan hal berbuat apa yang baik. Sebab bukan apa yang aku kehendaki, yaitu yang baik, yang aku perbuat, melainkan apa yang tidak aku kehendaki, yaitu yang jahat, yang aku perbuat. Jadi jika aku berbuat apa yang tidak aku kehendaki, maka bukan lagi aku yang memperbuatnya, tetapi dosa yang diam di dalam aku. Aku, manusia celaka! Siapakah yang akan melepaskan aku dari tubuh maut ini?" (Roma 7:18-20, 24). Adam pertama, kerana sifatnya yang berdosa tidak mampu menjadi manusia yang saleh, menyenangkan Tuhan. Manusia ini memiliki kehidupan namun hidup dengan sifat kedagingannya yang mengarah pada kematian meskipun ia mungkin memiliki bentuk kesalehan (2 Timotius 3: 5).

Alkitab membandingkan manusia pertama dengan Yesus Kristus, Adam Kedua, yang datang untuk menebus kita. Alkitab berkata, "Sebab itu hendaklah dosa jangan berkuasa lagi di dalam tubuhmu yang fana, supaya kamu jangan lagi menuruti keinginannya. Dan janganlah kamu menyerahkan anggota-anggota tubuhmu kepada dosa untuk dipakai sebagai senjata kelaliman, tetapi serahkanlah dirimu kepada Tuhan sebagai orang-orang, yang dahulu mati, tetapi yang sekarang hidup. Dan serahkanlah anggota-anggota tubuhmu kepada Tuhan untuk menjadi senjata-senjata kebenaran. Sebab kamu tidak akan dikuasai lagi oleh dosa, karena kamu tidak berada di bawah hukum Taurat, tetapi di bawah kasih karunia" (Roma 6:12-14). Mereka yang ditebus di dalam Kristus menjalani kehidupan yang Tuhan inginkan bagi mereka untuk hidup, menjalani kehidupan yang positif dan berkemenangan atas sifat dosa mereka dan menyenangkan bagi Tuhan.

Setiap orang harus memutuskan siapa empunya dirinya, sama ada kepada Adam pertama, yang menjalani gaya hidup kedagingan yang berdosa atau Adam Kedua, Yesus Kristus, yang telah menebus kita dari dosa dan kematian dan hidup oleh kasih karunia Tuhan melalui iman, kehidupan yang saleh yang menyenangkan bagi Tuhan (Efesus 2: 8). Alkitab memberi kita perbezaan antara Adam pertama dan Adam Kedua.

1. MANUSIA YANG DITEBUS MENERIMA TANGGUNGJAWABNYA UNTUK HIDUP KEHIDUPAN YANG TUHAN YANG MAKSUDKAN BAGINYA

Alkitab memberi kita kisah tentang jatuhnya manusia pertama, Adam, "TUHAN Tuhan mengambil manusia itu dan menempatkannya dalam taman Eden untuk mengusahakan dan memelihara taman itu. Lalu TUHAN Tuhan memberi perintah ini kepada manusia: "Semua pohon dalam taman ini boleh kau makan buahnya dengan bebas, tetapi pohon pengetahuan tentang yang baik dan yang jahat itu, janganlah kau makan buahnya, sebab pada hari engkau memakannya, pastilah engkau mati"" (Kejadian 2:15-17). "Adapun ular ialah yang paling cerdik dari segala binatang di darat yang dijadikan oleh TUHAN Tuhan. Ular itu berkata kepada perempuan itu: "Tentulah Tuhan berfirman: Semua pohon dalam taman ini jangan kamu makan buahnya, bukan?" Lalu sahut perempuan itu kepada ular itu: "Buah pohon-pohonan dalam taman ini boleh kami makan, tetapi tentang buah pohon yang ada di tengah-tengah taman, Tuhan berfirman: 'Jangan kamu makan ataupun raba buah itu, nanti kamu mati.'" Tetapi ular itu berkata kepada perempuan itu: "Sekali-kali kamu tidak akan mati, tetapi Tuhan mengetahui, bahwa pada waktu kamu memakannya matamu



akan terbuka, dan kamu akan menjadi seperti Tuhan, tahu tentang yang baik dan yang jahat." Perempuan itu melihat, bahwa buah pohon itu baik untuk dimakan dan sedap kelihatannya. lagipula pohon itu menarik hati karena memberi pengertian. Lalu ia mengambil dari buahnya dan dimakannya dan diberikannya juga kepada suaminya yang bersama-sama dengan dia, dan suaminyapun memakannya (Kejadian 3:1-6). Pencobaan-pencobaan seperti itu biasa bagi manusia hari ini, nafsu daging, nafsu mata dan keangkuhan hidup. Adam pertama gagal untuk mengambil tanggung jawab dan menolak kepasifan dalam peranannya sebagai seorang lelaki dan seorang suami. Adam gagal dalam tanggungjawabnya untuk melindungi dan menyokong isterinya pada saat diperlukan dengan melatih kepemimpinan dan kepemimpinan yang diberikan oleh Tuhan, tetapi memilih untuk mengikuti isterinya dalam ketidaktaatan.

Sebaliknya, Adam yang Kedua, Yesus Kristus, ketika dicobai di padang belantara (Lukas 4:1-13), Dia menanggapi Firman Tuhan. Lelaki dalam Kristus tahu Firman Tuhan dan melakukan kehendak Tuhan. Mereka memahami peranan mereka dan mengetahui tanggungjawab mereka. Mereka dipanggil untuk menjadi imam rumah tangga mereka, untuk mengetahui dan mengajar Firman Tuhan (1 Petrus 2:9). Mereka harus mencintai, melindungi dan menyediakan untuk keluarga mereka.

Paulus berkata kepada mereka yang ada di dalam Kristus Yesus, "Hendaklah kamu dalam hidupmu bersama, menaruh pikiran dan perasaan yang terdapat juga dalam Kristus Yesus, yang walaupun dalam rupa Tuhan, tidak menganggap kesetaraan dengan Tuhan itu sebagai milik yang harus dipertahankan, melainkan telah mengosongkan diri-Nya sendiri, dan mengambil rupa seorang hamba, dan menjadi sama dengan manusia. Dan dalam keadaan sebagai manusia, la telah merendahkan diri-Nya dan taat sampai mati, bahkan sampai mati di kayu salib" (Filipi 2:5-8). Orang yang ada di dalam Kristus tidak pasif terhadap kemusnahan sosial dan rohani tetapi menerima tanggung jawab mereka dalam menjalani kehidupan yang Tuhan inginkan bagi mereka.

2. MANUSIA YANG DITEBUS ADALAH SEORANG PEMIMPIN DAN BERSIFAT TABAH

Alkitab berkata, "Tetapi aku mau, supaya kamu mengetahui hal ini, yaitu Kepala dari tiap-tiap laki-laki ialah Kristus, kepala dari perempuan ialah laki-laki dan Kepala dari Kristus ialah Tuhan" (1 Korintus 11:3). Lelaki diciptakan untuk mengambil kepemimpinan dengan keberanian. Manusia pertama Adam gagal menjadi pemimpin yang berani dan kepala keluarganya ketika dicobai. Sebaliknya, ia membiarkan isterinya memimpin dalam apa yang secara khusus adalah peranannya yang mengakibatkan jatuhnya umat manusia.

Adam Kedua, Yesus Kristus adalah teladan kita (Lukas 4:1-13):

- Yesus terbukti berkuasa atas nafsuNya ketika Dia menolak penyerahan pada keinginan daging ketika Setan meminta Dia untuk mengubah batu menjadi roti, kerana Dia adalah Anak Tuhan, dan juga kerana keangkihan hidup, ketika Ia dicobai untuk diberikan kerajaan di dunia ini jika Dia menyembah Setan.
- Yesus tahu Firman Tuhan. Dia berkata, "Jauhkan diri kau, Iblis! Ada tertulis: Engkau harus menyembah Tuhan, Tuhanmu, dan hanya kepada Dia sajalah engkau berbakti!" (Lukas 4:8). Yesus memiliki ketabahan untuk menghadapi Setan dan tidak menyerah seperti Adam pertama.
- Yesus rendah hati. Dia datang untuk melayani. Yesus berkata, "Ada firman: Jangan engkau mencobai Tuhan, Tuhanmu!... hanya kepada Dia sajalah engkau berbakti!" (Lukas 4:12, 8).

Tanggung jawab manusia bukan hanya untuk menjadi mencari nafkah keluarga tetapi untuk

menjadi seorang imam di rumahnya, seorang nabi Tuhan untuk memberitakan Firman Tuhan dan seorang raja untuk memerintah dengan saleh di rumahnya ketika krisis terjadi (Wahyu 1:6). Dia harus mengajarkan Firman Tuhan dan memberi panduan kepada keluarganya, menjadi pemimpin dan kepala keluarga untuk memberikan keyakinan dan keselamatan.

3. MANUSIA YANG DITEBUS MEMANDANG KE HADAPAN DENGAN SUKACITA UNTUK GANJARANNYA

Tuhan merancang kedewasaan untuk membebaskan dan memberi ganiaran. Tanggung jawab seorang lelaki tidak pernah dimaksudkan untuk membebankan. Manusia di dalam Kristus melakukan kehendak Tuhan dengan sukacita. Alkitab berkata, "Karena kita mempunyai banyak saksi, bagaikan awan yang mengelilingi kita, marilah kita menanggalkan semua beban dan dosa yang begitu merintangi kita, dan berlomba dengan tekun dalam perlombaan yang diwajibkan bagi kita. Marilah kita melakukannya dengan mata yang tertuju kepada Yesus, yang memimpin kita dalam iman, dan yang membawa iman kita itu kepada kesempurnaan, yang dengan mengabaikan kehinaan tekun memikul salib ganti sukacita yang disediakan bagi Dia, yang sekarang duduk di sebelah kanan takhta Tuhan" (Ibrani 12:1-2). Melakukan kehendak Tuhan memberi kita visi, tujuan, dan kepuasan dalam hidup. Panggilan kepada manusia seperti yang dimaksudkan Tuhan lebih dari sekadar melaksanakan tanggungjawab dan membuat pengorbanan. Pada prinsipnya panggilan untuk hidup kebebasan untuk hidup, mengasihi dan melayani Tuhan dan sesama kita. Setan berhasil menipu Adam pertama yang merompak tujuan yang dimaksudkan Tuhan bagi manusia untuk menjadi manusia sejati setelah Adam Kedua, Yesus Kristus. Namun, tanggung jawab dan pilihan ada pada kita masing-masing.

Mari kita memilih untuk menjadi manusia yang dimaksudkan Tuhan seperti Adam Kedua, Yesus Kristus untuk hidup sebagai pemenang atas keinginan daging, keinginan mata dan keangkuhan hidup. Alkitab berkata, "Segala perkara dapat kutanggung di dalam Dia yang memberi kekuatan kepadaku" (Filipi 4:13).

第二个亚当 -耶稣基督

文: 古纳南主任牧师

圣经告诉我们:「首先的人亚当成了有生命的人;末后的亚当成了赐生命的灵。第一个人是出于地,是属于尘土;第二个人是出于天。那属尘土的怎样,凡属尘土的也都怎样;属天的怎样,凡属天的也都怎样。」(林前15:45,47-48)

第一个亚当没能成为他被造的那个人。圣经上说,神造人成为一个有灵的活人,但是人因不顺服而犯罪。犯罪就是不中目标。罪的刑罚是死亡。世界是以他的体格、他的力量、物质的成功和他在社会中的地位来定义第一个亚当。圣经将第一个亚当描述为可怜无助和必死,「我也知道,住在我里面的,就是我肉体之中,没有善。因为立志为善由得我,只是行出来由不得我。我所愿意的善,我不去做;我所不愿意的恶,我反而去做。如果我去做我不愿意做的,就不是我做的,而是住在我里面的罪做的。我真苦啊!谁能救我脱离这必死的身体呢?」(罗7:18-20,24)。第一个亚当,因为他有罪的本性,不能成为义人,为神所喜悦。这个人有生命,但他随从肉体来生活,结果就是死亡,尽管他可能有敬虔的外貌(提后3:5)。

圣经将第一个人与耶稣基督,第二个亚当作比较,后者来为要救赎我们。圣经上说:「所以,不要让罪在你们必死的身上掌权,使你们顺从身体的私欲。也不要把你们的肢体献给罪作不义的工具,倒要像从死人中活着的人,把自己献给神,并把你们的肢体献给神作义的工具。罪必不能作你们的主,因你们不在律法之下,而是在恩典之下」(罗6:12-14)。那些在基督里被救赎的人,过着神想要他们过的生活,过着一种积极的、胜利的生活,胜过了他们的罪恶本性,并且讨神喜悦。

每个人都必须决定他属于谁,是否属于第一个亚当,他过着一个罪恶属肉体的生活方式,还是属于第二个亚当,耶稣基督,他把我们从罪恶和死亡中救赎出来,并靠神的恩典藉著信心过一个公义的生活,是神所喜悦的(弗2:8)。圣经给了我们第一个亚当和第二个亚当之间的区别。

1. 蒙救赎的人接受他的责任去过神为他预备 的生活

圣经给我们讲述了第一个人, 亚当的堕落, 「耶 和华神把那人安置在伊甸园,让他耕耘看管。耶 和华神吩咐那人说:"园中各样树上所出的,你可 以随意吃,只是知善恶的树所出的,你不可吃, 因为你吃它的日子必定死!"|(创2:15-17)。「耶和 华神所造的,惟有蛇比田野一切的走兽更狡猾。蛇 对女人说:"神岂是真说,你们不可吃园中任何树 上所出的吗?"女人对蛇说:"园中树上的果子,我们 都可以吃;只是园子中间那棵树的果子,神曾说: '你们不可吃,也不可摸,免得你们死。'"蛇对女 人说:"你们不一定死;因为神知道,你们吃的日 子眼睛就开了,你们就像神一样知道善恶。"于是 女人见那棵树好作食物,又悦人的眼目,那树令 人喜爱,能使人有智慧,她就摘下果子吃了,又给 了与她一起的丈夫,他也吃了」(创3:1-6)。这种 试探在今天的人类中很常见,好比肉体的情欲,眼 目的情欲和今生的骄傲。第一个亚当没有承担责 任, 拒绝被动地扮演一个男人和丈夫角色。亚当 没有尽到保护和支持他的妻子的责任,在她有 需要的时候通过行使神赋予他作头的和领导的 能力,但却选择跟随她的不顺从。

与之相比,第二个亚当,耶稣基督,当在旷野被试探的时候(路4:1-13),他用神的话来回应。在基督里的男人知道神的话,并遵行神的旨意。他们明白自己的角色,也知道自己的责任。他们被召在自己的家里作祭司,要认识和教导神的话(彼前2:9)。他们要爱、保护和供养他们的家庭。

保罗对那些在基督耶稣里的人说:「你们当以基督耶稣的心为心:他本有神的形像,却不坚持自己与神同等;反倒虚己,取了奴仆的形像,成为人的样式;既有人的样子,就谦卑自己,存心顺服,以至于死,且死在十字架上」(腓2:5-8)。在基督里的人,不是被动地面对社会和灵性上的堕落,而是接受他们的责任,过神定意为他们预备的生活。

2. 蒙救赎的人是领袖, 是勇敢的

圣经上说:「但是我要你们知道:基督是男人的头; 男人是女人的头;神是基督的头」(林前11:3)。 人被造就是要勇敢地领导。第一个人亚当,当被 试探时,没能成为一个勇敢的领袖和他家的头。 相反地,他允许他的妻子扮演他的角色发挥领导 作用,从而导致了人类的堕落。

第二个亚当,耶稣基督是我们的榜样(路4:1-13)

 耶稣被证明他征服了欲望,当撒旦要求耶稣 把石头变成面包因他是神的儿子,耶稣拒绝 向肉体的情欲屈服。当耶稣被试探,如果愿 意敬拜撒旦他将得到天下万国,他胜过了今 生的骄傲。



- 耶稣知道神的话。他说:「撒但,退到我后边去!经上记着:'要拜主—你的神,惟独事奉他。'」耶稣有勇气面对撒旦,不像第一个亚当那样屈服。
- 耶稣很谦卑。他来是要服事人。耶稣说道:「不可试探主—你的神,惟独事奉他」(路4:12, 8)。

男人的责任不仅仅是养家糊口,而是在他家里作祭司,作神的先知传讲神的话语。当危机发生时,在家里作敬虔施行治理的君王(启1:6)。他要教导神的话语,并引导他的家庭,作为一个领导者和家庭的头,提供自信心和安全。

3. 蒙救赎的人满怀喜乐地期待着他的奖赏

神设计人是为自由和有奖赏的。人的责任从来都不是一种负累。在基督里的人以喜乐的心遵行神的旨意。圣经上说道:「所以,既然我们有这许多见证人如同云彩围绕着我们,就该卸下各样的担和紧紧缠累的罪,以坚忍的心奔那摆在我们头的路程,仰望我们信心的创始成终者耶稣,他因那摆在前面的喜乐,轻看羞辱,忍受了十字,他的苦难,如今已坐在神宝座的右边」(来12:1-2)。遵行神的旨意给我们生活有异象、目标和满足。神对人的呼召的心意不仅仅是履行职责和做出,会在原则上是对自由生活的呼召,去生活,是和事奉神和我们的邻居。撒旦成功地欺骗了第一个亚当,夺去神对人类的既定目的成为真正的人,效法第二个亚当耶稣基督。然而,责任和选择取决于我们每个人。

让我们选择成为合神心意的人效法第二个亚当,耶稣基督,以胜利者的身份生活,胜过肉体的欲望、眼目的欲望和今生的骄傲。圣经上说道:「我靠着那加给我力量的,凡事都能做」(腓4:13)。

It was a wonderful time of recognizing and celebrating the rangers' physical and spiritual growth.
















HANGING OUT AT THE MOVIE

EMPOWERED TO HELP THOSE WITH DEPRESSION

On Saturday, 28 April 2018, Dimensions had its third monthly meeting at Calvary Convention Centre with a seminar on "Coping with Depression" that was open to both men and women. Dr. Vincent Wong, a consultant psychiatrist who sits on the board of Focus on the Family Malaysia, spoke on this vital topic to a 300-strong crowd.

He spoke on the common myths about mental illness and highlighted the symptoms as well as common causes of depression such as genetic makeup, family upbringing, biochemical imbalance, and stress, just to mention a few. Alcohol and substance abuse are also risk factors. He explained, however, that depression is rarely due to a single factor. The weakening of social support systems in society also plays a role in the increasing rate of





depression. The World Health Organization statistics show that 800,000 people commit suicide every year and this was the second leading cause of death among young people ages 15 to 29.

Dr. Vincent also addressed ways in which the community and family can help depressed persons overcome the stigma of mental illness and cope with their condition. Besides seeking professional treatment and counselling, loving support from family and the church goes a long way in making a difference, as is being grounded in God's Word, and being assured of one's identity in Christ. With God, all things are possible – there is hope of recovery for the depressed as they find their worth, sense of purpose and meaning in God's love and community care.


