Proclaim

THE GOSPEL ... TILL HE COMES!

MATTHEW 24:14

The Lord Jesus Christ has chosen and commissioned us to proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom. A Commission is not to be interpreted but to be obeyed (Matthew 28:18-20). The Gospel of Luke Chapter 10:1-16 gives us an account of Jesus sending out seventy-two individuals from whom we can learn some valuable lessons to go and proclaim the Gospel.

Jesus teaches that the labourers are sent through prayer (Luke 10:2). Proclaiming the Gospel is a spiritual work that God has sent us to do and the Holy Spirit anoints us when we respond as an answer to prayer. Secondly, the Lord sends us as sheep among wolves (Luke 10:3). We are sheep because we have a shepherd. Jesus said, *"I am the good shepherd; I know my own sheep, and they know me, just as my Father knows me and I know the Father. So I sacrifice my life for the sheep"* (John 10:14-15). He will keep us safe and not allow us to fall or stumble when we do His will.

Jesus provides us with valuable instructions when we go to proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom:

WE CAN DEPEND ON THE LORD (Luke 10:4)

We are not to allow the things of this world to become our priority and main concerns. We are to depend on God, our Provider. Jesus addresses these concerns and said, *"Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need"* (Matthew 6:33). We are to be His witnesses and He will be faithful to meet our need, sustain and strengthen us. Paul testified to this truth, *"Not that I was ever in need, for I have learned how to be content with whatever I have. I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength"* (Philippians 4:11-13). Paul's principle of serving was a principle of dependence on God. He did not depend on his own ability but believed God to be his sufficiency. Jesus also instructed us not to get side-tracked in proclaiming the Gospel. The time is short and Jesus said, *"We must quickly carry out the tasks assigned us by the one who sent us. The night is coming, and then no one can work"* (John 9:4).

OUR MESSAGE IS ONE OF PEACE (Luke 10:5-6)

Peace is the greatest need in the world today. The

Gospel we proclaim is a message of peace. The Bible says, *“As it is written: ‘How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!’”* (Romans 10:15b NKJV). When we have peace with God, we also have the peace of God. God’s favour is with us to be a blessing to those we share the Gospel. There is no real peace without God who is the Prince of Peace. You are God’s chosen people to bring the Gospel of peace to the world that seeks and hungers for peace.

It was the Biblical pattern of the early church to teach and preach the Gospel. The Bible says, *“And every day, in the Temple and from house to house, they continued to teach and preach this message: ‘Jesus is the Messiah’”* (Acts 5:42) and *“I never shrank back from telling you what you needed to hear, either publicly or in your homes”* (Acts 20:20). We have this powerful message and the privilege to bring to those who do not have peace with God. House to house evangelism is the best method the church can adopt. We are to bring the peace of God to every home for the entire household to be saved. The Bible says, *“Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household”* (Acts 16:31). The peace of God brings stability and security to the family and to the household.

WE PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL TO GLORIFY GOD, NOT SEEK MATERIAL GAIN (Luke 10:7)

God’s method is His people and we are worthy of our labour. The Bible says, *“Elders who do their work well should be respected and paid well, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching. For the Scripture says, ‘You must not muzzle an ox to keep it from eating as it treads out the grain.’ And in another place, ‘Those who work deserve their pay!’”* (1 Timothy 5:17-18).

We are not to seek after worldly gain for Paul exhorts us, *“If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things*

above, not on things on the earth” (Colossians 3:1-2 NKJV). Our dependence should be on God alone. When you walk in obedience and do God’s will, He will bless you and have His hand upon your situations. When Moses came of age and had to make a choice, he chose to be called the son of sufferers instead of being called the son of Pharaoh’s daughter (Hebrews 11:24-26). In the same way, we have a choice whether to be called sons of God who walk in faith and righteousness or sons of this world who desire materialistic gain.

WE GO IN THE SPIRIT OF HOSPITALITY AND ADAPTABILITY (Luke 10:8)

We are not to curse those who reject us when we proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom. They serve other gods and do not know the one true God, for the god of this world has blinded their eyes. However, the Bible says, *“Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God”* (1 Peter 4:9-10 NKJV). Hospitality is one of the gifts God gives to His people to serve Him. It is the gift to love and enjoy people. God gives specific gifts to each of us to serve Him and we are called to be faithful stewards of the gifts of God.

Jesus, while He lived on earth, went about doing good in words and in deeds. He set this example for believers today. The Bible says, *“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many”* (Matthew 20:28). Jesus also urged believers to *“Heal the sick, raise the dead, cure those with leprosy, and cast out demons. Give as freely as you have received! Don’t take any money in your money belts – no gold, silver, or even copper coins”* (Matthew 10:8-9). Jesus was anointed by the Holy Spirit to minister to people. The Bible says, *“And you know that God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. Then Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him”* (Acts 10:38).

WE ARE TO WALK AWAY FROM REJECTERS (Luke 10:10-15)

As human beings, we get hurt when somebody rejects us. In these circumstances, we are to remember that we cannot make believers out of people. It is the Holy Spirit that takes our words and convicts people. The Bible says, *“And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God’s righteousness, and of the coming judgment”* (John 16:8).

The dangers of rejecting the Gospel:

- i. To know and to reject is greater judgment than not knowing. These are people who once accepted and believed in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. The Bible says, *“But someone who does not know, and then does something wrong, will be punished only lightly. When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much, even more will be required”* (Luke 12:48).
- ii. To profess only is as good as to reject. The Bible says, *“And the judgment is based on this fact: God’s light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil”* (John 3:19). Believers who have become lovers of themselves do not really love God like they say they do. They live a hypocritical lifestyle; they tell others what to do but do not do what they profess. The Bible warns us how God deals with these rejecters, *“While you were doing these wicked things, says the Lord, I spoke to you about it repeatedly, but you would not listen. I called out to you, but you refused to answer. So just as I destroyed Shiloh, I will now destroy this Temple that bears my name, this Temple that you trust in for help, this place that I gave to you and your ancestors. And I will send you out of my sight into exile, just as I did your relatives, the people of Israel”* (Jeremiah 7:13-15).

- iii. To constantly have a witness and to reject is sure of hell. The Bible says, *“But because you are stubborn and refuse to turn from your sin, you are storing up terrible punishment for yourself. For a day of anger is coming, when God’s righteous judgment will be revealed”* (Romans 2:5) and *“But cowards, unbelievers, the corrupt, murderers, the immoral, those who practice witchcraft, idol worshipers, and all liars—their fate is in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the second death.”* (Revelation 21:8).

WE ARE GOD’S MESSENGERS (Luke 10:16)

When we go with the Gospel of the Kingdom, we go as God’s messengers. We are God’s hands and feet to minister to the people. When the people reject us, God Himself is rejected. Jesus said, *“Anyone who receives you receives me, and anyone who receives me receives the Father who sent me”* (Matthew 10:40) and *“I tell you the truth, when you refused to help the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were refusing to help me”* (Matthew 25:45-46).

God has given us the Good News of the Gospel to proclaim to the world, peace and hope. Let us avail ourselves, depending entirely on the Lord to be our Provider for every need we have. We need to depend on the Holy Spirit’s anointing to lead people to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. Let us pray and believe that many will receive Jesus Christ before He returns as the King of kings and Lord of lords.

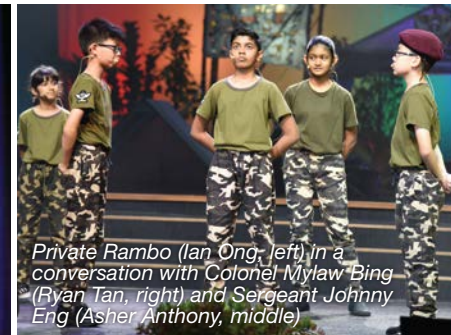

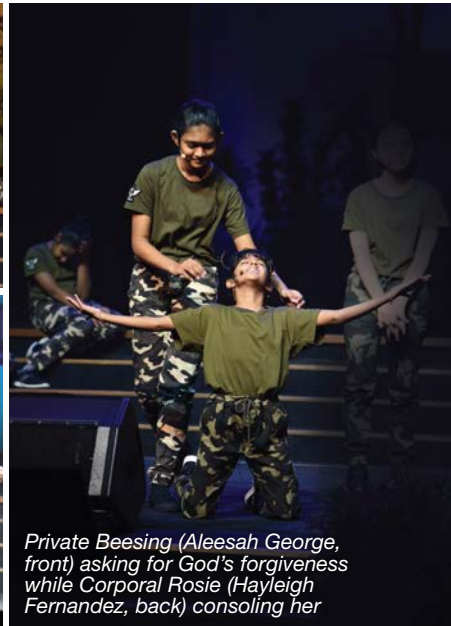

Yesus berkata, “Akulah gembala yang baik dan Aku mengenal domba-domba-Ku dan domba-domba-Ku mengenal Aku sama seperti Bapa mengenal Aku dan Aku mengenal Bapa, dan Aku memberikan nyawa-Ku bagi domba-domba-Ku” (Yohanes 10:14-15). Dia akan melindungi dan tidak membiarkan kita jatuh atau tersandung ketika kita melakukan kehendakNya.

Yesus memberi kita petunjuk yang berharga ketika kita pergi untuk memberitakan Injil Kerajaan:

KITA DAPAT BERSANDAR PADA TUHAN (Lukas 10:4)

Kita tidak boleh membiarkan hal-hal dunia ini menjadi keutamaan dan perhatian utama kita. Kita harus bersandar pada Tuhan, Pembekal kita. Yesus peduli akan keprihatinan ini dan berkata, “Tetapi carilah dahulu Kerajaan Tuhan dan kebenarannya, maka semuanya itu akan ditambahkan kepadamu” (Matius 6:33). Kita harus menjadi saksi-Nya dan Dia akan setia untuk memenuhi keperluan kita, mendokong dan menguatkan kita. Paulus memberi kesaksian tentang kebenaran ini, “Kukatakan ini bukanlah kerana kekurangan, sebab aku telah belajar mencukupkan diri dalam segala keadaan. Aku tahu apa

itu kekurangan dan aku tahu apa itu kelimpahan. Dalam segala hal dan dalam segala perkara tidak ada sesuatu yang merupakan rahasia bagiku; baik dalam hal kenyang, maupun dalam hal kelaparan, baik dalam hal kelimpahan maupun dalam hal kekurangan. Segala perkara dapat kutanggung di dalam Dia yang memberi kekuatan kepadaku” (Filipi 4:11-13). Prinsip pelayanan Paulus adalah prinsip ketergantungan pada Tuhan. Dia tidak bersandar pada kemampuannya sendiri tetapi percaya bahawa Tuhan adalah kecukupannya. Yesus juga mengarahkan kita untuk tidak mengalihkan fokus dalam memberitakan Injil. Waktunya singkat dan Yesus berkata, “Kita harus mengerjakan pekerjaan Dia yang mengutus Aku, selama masih siang; akan datang malam, di mana tidak ada seorangpun yang dapat bekerja” (Yohanes 9:4).

MESEJ KITA ADALAH TENTANG KEDAMAIAN (Lukas 10:5-6)

Kedamaian adalah keperluan terbesar di dunia saat ini. Injil yang kita nyatakan adalah mesej kedamaian. Alkitab mengatakan, “Dan bagaimana mereka dapat memberitakan-Nya, jika mereka tidak diutus? Seperti ada tertulis: “Betapa indahnya kedatangan mereka yang membawa kabar baik!” (Roma 10:15). Ketika kita memiliki damai dengan Tuhan, kita juga memiliki kedamaian Tuhan. Kebaikan Tuhan ada bersama kita untuk menjadi berkat bagi mereka yang kita sampaikan Injil. Tidak ada kedamaian sejati tanpa Tuhan yang adalah Raja Damai. Kamu adalah umat pilihan Tuhan untuk membawa Injil kedamaian ke dunia yang mencari dan lapar untuk kedamaian.

Sememangnya adalah cara Alkitabiah dari gereja awal dulu untuk mengajar dan memberitakan Injil. Alkitab mengatakan, “Dan setiap hari mereka melanjutkan pengajaran mereka di Bait Tuhan dan di rumah-rumah orang dan memberitakan Injil tentang Yesus yang adalah Mesias” (Kisah Para Rasul 5:42) dan “Sungguhpun demikian aku tidak pernah melalaikan apa yang berguna bagi kamu. Semua kuberitakan dan kuajarkan kepada kamu, baik di muka umum maupun dalam perkumpulan-perkumpulan di rumah kamu” (Kisah Para Rasul 20:20). Kita memiliki mesej yang berkuasa ini dan hak istimewa untuk membawa kepada mereka yang tidak memiliki kedamaian dengan Tuhan. Penginjilan dari rumah ke rumah adalah cara terbaik yang dapat dilakukan oleh gereja. Kita harus membawa damai Tuhan ke setiap rumah untuk seluruh keluarga agar diselamatkan. Alkitab berkata, “Jawab mereka: “Percayalah kepada Tuhan Yesus Kristus dan engkau akan selamat, engkau dan seisi rumahmu” (Kisah Para Rasul 16:31). Damai Tuhan membawa kestabilan dan keselamatan kepada keluarga dan rumah tangga.

KITA MEMBERITAKAN INJIL UNTUK MEMULIAKAN TUHAN, BUKAN UNTUK Mencari Keuntungan KEBENDAAN (Lukas 10:7)

Cara Tuhan adalah umatNya dan kita adalah layak untuk bekerja. Alkitab mengatakan, “Penatua-penatua yang baik pimpinannya patut dihormati dua kali lipat, terutama mereka yang dengan jerih payah berkhotbah dan mengajar. Bukankah Kitab Suci berkata: ‘Janganlah engkau memberangus mulut lembu yang sedang mengirik,’ dan lagi ‘seorang pekerja patut mendapat upahnya’” (1 Timotius 5:17-18).

Kita tidak mencari demi keuntungan duniawi kerana Paulus menasihati kita, “Karena itu, kalau kamu dibangkitkan bersama dengan Kristus, carilah perkara yang di atas, di mana Kristus ada, duduk di sebelah kanan Tuhan. Pikirkanlah perkara yang di atas, bukan yang di bumi” (Kolose 3:1-2). Ketergantungan kita seharusnya hanya pada Tuhan. Ketika kamu berjalan dalam ketaatan dan melakukan kehendak Tuhan, Dia akan memberkati kamu dan tanganNya akan berada atas situasi kamu. Ketika Musa telah dewasa dan harus membuat pilihan, ia memilih untuk dipanggil anak penderita daripada disebut anak puteri Firaun (Ibrani 11:24-26). Dengan cara yang sama, kita memiliki pilihan sama ada akan dipanggil anak-anak Tuhan yang berjalan dalam iman dan kebenaran atau anak-anak di dunia ini yang menginginkan keuntungan kebendaan.

KITA BERJALAN DALAM SEMANGAT KERAMAHAN DAN PENYESUAIAN (Lukas 10:8)

Kita tidak mengutuk mereka yang menolak kita ketika kita memberitakan Injil Kerajaan. Mereka melayani tuhan-tuhan lain dan tidak mengenal Tuhan Yang Maha Esa, kerana tuhan dunia ini telah membutuhkan mata mereka. Namun, Alkitab berkata, “Berilah tumpangan seorang akan yang lain dengan tidak bersungut-sungut. Layanilah seorang akan yang lain, sesuai dengan karunia yang telah diperoleh tiap-tiap orang sebagai pengurus yang baik dari kasih karunia Tuhan” (1 Petrus 4:9-10). Keramahan adalah salah satu karunia yang Tuhan berikan kepada umatNya untuk melayaniNya. Ini adalah karunia untuk mengasihi dan menyenangkan orang lain. Tuhan memberikan karunia khusus kepada kita masing-masing untuk melayani Dia dan kita dipanggil untuk menjadi pelayan setia dari karunia-karunia Tuhan.

Yesus, ketika Dia hidup di bumi, melakukan kebaikan dalam kata-kata dan perbuatan. Dia memberikan teladan ini bagi orang percaya hari ini. Alkitab berkata, “sama seperti Anak Manusia datang bukan untuk dilayani, melainkan untuk melayani dan untuk memberikan nyawa-Nya menjadi tebusan bagi banyak orang” (Matius 20:28). Yesus juga menggesa orang

percaya untuk “Sembuhkanlah orang sakit; bangkitkanlah orang mati; tahirkanlah orang kusta; usirlah setan-setan. Kamu telah memperolehnya dengan cuma-cuma, karena itu berikanlah pula dengan cuma-cuma. Janganlah kamu membawa emas atau perak atau tembaga dalam ikat pinggangmu” (Matius 10:8-9). Yesus diurapi oleh Roh Kudus untuk melayani manusia. Alkitab berkata, “yaitu tentang Yesus dari Nazaret: bagaimana Tuhan mengurapi Dia dengan Roh Kudus dan kuat kuasa, Dia, yang berjalan berkeliling sambil berbuat baik dan menyembuhkan semua orang yang dikuasai Iblis, sebab Tuhan menyertai Dia” (Kisah Para Rasul 10:38).

KITA HARUS PERGI DARI MEREKA YANG MENOLAK (Lukas 10:10-15)

Sebagai manusia, kita terluka ketika seseorang menolak kita. Dalam keadaan ini, kita harus ingat bahwa kita tidak boleh menjadikan seseorang itu seorang Kristian. Itu adalah kerja Roh Kudus yang mengambil kata-kata kita dan meyakinkan orang. Alkitab mengatakan, “Dan kalau Ia datang, Ia akan menginsafkan dunia akan dosa, kebenaran dan penghakiman” (Yohanes 16:8).

Bahaya menolak Injil:

- i. Mengetahui dan menolak adalah penghakiman yang lebih besar daripada tidak tahu. Mereka adalah orang-orang yang pernah menerima dan percaya kepada Yesus Kristus sebagai Tuhan dan Juruselamat mereka. Alkitab berkata, “Tetapi barangsiapa tidak tahu akan kehendak tuannya dan melakukan apa yang harus mendatangkan pukulan, ia akan menerima sedikit pukulan. Setiap orang yang kepadanya banyak diberi, dari padanya akan banyak dituntut, dan kepada siapa yang banyak dipercayakan, dari padanya akan lebih banyak lagi dituntut” (Lukas 12:48).
- ii. Untuk hanya mengaku samalah seperti menolak. Alkitab mengatakan, “Dan inilah hukuman itu: Terang telah datang ke dalam dunia, tetapi manusia lebih menyukai kegelapan dari pada terang, sebab perbuatan-perbuatan mereka jahat” (Yohanes 3:19). Orang-orang percaya yang telah mengasihi diri mereka sendiri tidak benar-benar mengasihi Tuhan seperti yang mereka katakan. Mereka menjalani gaya hidup yang munafik; mereka memberi tahu orang lain apa yang harus dilakukan tetapi tidak melakukan apa yang mereka anuti. Alkitab memperingatkan kita bagaimana Tuhan berurusan dengan orang-orang yang menolak ini, “Maka sekarang, oleh karena kamu telah melakukan segala perbuatan itu juga, demikianlah firman TUHAN, dan oleh karena kamu

tidak mau mendengarkan, sekalipun Aku berbicara kepadamu terus-menerus, dan kamu tidak mau menjawab, sekalipun Aku berseru kepadamu, karena itulah kepada rumah, yang atasnya nama-Ku diserukan dan yang kamu andalkan itu, dan kepada tempat, yang telah Kuberikan kepadamu dan kepada nenek moyangmu itu, akan Kulakukan seperti yang telah Kulakukan kepada Silo; Aku akan melemparkan kamu dari hadapan-Ku, seperti semua saudaramu, yakni seluruh keturunan Efraim, telah Kulemparkan” (Yeremia 7:13-15).

- iii. Untuk terus memiliki suatu saksi dan menolak adalah pasti neraka. Alkitab berkata, “Tetapi oleh kekerasan hatimu yang tidak mau bertobat, engkau menimbun murka atas dirimu sendiri pada hari waktu mana murka dan hukuman Tuhan yang adil akan dinyatakan” (Roma 2:5) dan “Tetapi orang-orang penakut, orang-orang yang tidak percaya, orang-orang keji, orang-orang pembunuh, orang-orang sundal, tukang-tukang sihir, penyembah-penyembah berhala dan semua pendusta, mereka akan mendapat bagian mereka di dalam lautan yang menyala-nyala oleh api dan belerang; inilah kematian yang kedua.” (Wahyu 21:8).

KITA ADALAH UTUSAN TUHAN (Lukas 10:16)

Ketika kita pergi dengan Injil Kerajaan, kita pergi sebagai utusan Tuhan. Kita adalah tangan dan kaki Tuhan untuk melayani orang. Ketika orang-orang menolak kita, Tuhan sendiri ditolak. Yesus berkata, “Barangsiapa menyambut kamu, ia menyambut Aku, dan barangsiapa menyambut Aku, ia menyambut Dia yang mengutus Aku” (Matius 10:40) dan “Maka Ia akan menjawab mereka: Aku berkata kepadamu, sesungguhnya segala sesuatu yang tidak kamu lakukan untuk salah seorang dari yang paling hina ini, kamu tidak melakukannya juga untuk Aku. Dan mereka ini akan masuk ke tempat siksaan yang kekal, tetapi orang benar ke dalam hidup yang kekal” (Matius 25:45-46).

Tuhan telah memberi kita kabar baik Injil untukewartakan kepada dunia, kedamaian dan harapan. Marilah kita menyediakan diri kita sendiri, bersandar sepenuhnya pada Tuhan untuk menjadi Pembekal kita untuk setiap keperluan yang kita miliki. Kita perlu bersandar pada urapan Roh Kudus untuk menuntun orang-orang kepada pengetahuan penyelamatan Yesus Kristus. Mari kita berdoa dan percaya bahwa banyak orang akan menerima Yesus Kristus sebelum Dia kembali sebagai Raja segala raja dan Tuhan di atas segala tuan.

主 耶稣基督拣选并授命我们去传扬天国的福音。这使命不是要被解释的，而是要顺服(太 28:18-20)。路加福音10:1-16，向我们讲述耶稣差遣了七十二个人出去，我们可以从中汲取一些宝贵的教训去传扬福音。耶稣教导我们，工人是藉着祷告被差遣出去的(路10:2)。传扬福音是神差遣我们去作的属灵工作和圣灵在我们回应祷告时膏抹我们。第二，主差遣我们如同羔羊进入狼群(路10:3)。我们是羊，因为我们有一位牧者。耶稣说道：「我是好牧人；我认识我的羊，我的羊也认识我，15正如父认识我，我也认识父一样；并且我为羊舍命」(约10:14-15)。当我们遵行他的旨意时，他会保护我们的安全，不让我们跌倒或失足。

当我们去传扬天国的福音时，耶稣给了我们宝贵的训示：

我们可以依靠主(路10:4)

我们不能让这个世界的万物成为我们的优先考虑和主要关切的事项。我们要依靠神，我们的供应者。耶稣处理了这些问题，并说道：「你们要先求神的国和他的义，这些东西都要加给你们了」(太6:33)。我们要作他的见证人，他必信实地满足我们的需要，眷顾和坚固我们。保罗见证了这一真理：「我并不是因缺乏而说这话，因为我已经学会无论在什么景况都可以知足。我知道怎样处卑贱，也知道怎样处丰富；或饱足或饥饿，或有余或缺乏，任何事情，任何景况，我都得了秘诀。我靠着那加给我力量的，凡事都能做」(腓4:11-13)。保罗事奉的原则是依靠神的原则。他不依靠自己的能力，而是相信神是他的充足。耶稣也教导我们在传福音时不要偏离目标。时间不多了，耶稣说道：「趁着白日，我们必须做差我来的那位的工；黑夜来到，就没有人能做工了」(约9:4)。

我们的信息是和平的信息(路10:5-6)

当今世界最大的需要是和平。我们所传扬的福音是和平的信息。圣经上说：「若没有奉差遣，怎能传道呢？如经上所记：“报福音、传喜信的人，他们的脚踪何等佳美！”」(罗10:15)当我们与神和好时，我们也有神的平安！

。神的恩惠与我们同在，使我们成为与那些分享福音的人的祝福。没有和平之君的神，就没有真正的平安。你是神拣选的子民，要把和平的福音带给寻求和渴望和平的世界。

教导和传福音是早期教会的圣经模式。圣经上说：「他们就每日在圣殿里，在家里，不住地教导人，传耶稣是基督的福音」（徒5:42）。「你们也知道，凡对你们有益的，我没有一样隐瞒不说的，或在公众面前，或在每一个人的家里，我都教导你们」（徒20:20）。我们有这强有力的信息和特权把它带给那些没有与神和好的人。逐家布道是教会所能采用的最佳方法。我们要把神的平安带给每一个家庭，使全家都得救。圣经上说：「当信主耶稣，你和你一家都必得救」（徒16:31）。神的平安给家庭和一家的人带来稳定和安全。

我们传扬福音是为了荣耀神，而不是追求物质利益(路10:7)

神的方法是他的子民，我们得工钱是应当的。圣经上说：「善于督导教会的长老，尤其是勤劳讲道教导人的，应该得到加倍的敬奉。因为经上说：“牛在踹谷的时候，不可笼住它的嘴”；又说：“工人得工资是应当的”」（提前5:17-18）。

我们不要追求世俗的利益，因为保罗劝勉我们说：「所以，既然你们已经与基督一同复活，就当求上面的事；那里有基督，坐在神的右边。你们要思考上面的事，不要思考地上的事」（西3:1-2）。我们应该只依靠神。当你顺服和遵行神的旨意，他必赐福给你，掌管你的生活情况。当摩西长大后，他必须做出选择，他选择被称为受凌辱之子，而不是被称为法老女儿之子（来11:24-26）。同样地，我们也有选择，是被称为神的儿女，凭信心和公义生活，或是被称为这个世界的儿女，贪图物质利益的人。

我们本着款待和适应的精神出去(路10:8)

当我们传扬天国的福音时，我们不应咒诅那些拒绝我们的人。他们事奉别神，却不认识独一的真神，因为他们被这世界的神弄瞎了心眼。然而，圣经上说：「你们要互相款待，不发怨言。人人要照自己所得的恩赐彼此服事，作神各种恩赐的好管家」（彼前4:9-10）。款待是神赐给他的子民服侍他的恩赐之一。它是爱人和享受与人交通的恩赐。神给我们每个人特定的恩赐来服侍他和我们被呼召作神各种恩赐的忠心管家。

耶稣住在地上的时候，他去到各处以言语和行为行善事。他为今天的信徒树立了榜样。圣经上说：「正如人子来，不是要受人的服事，乃是要服事人，并且要舍命，作多人的赎价。」（太20:28）。耶稣也敦促信徒：「要医治病人，使死人复活，使麻风病人洁净，把鬼赶出去。你们白白地得来，也要白白地给人。腰袋里不要带金银铜钱」（太10:8-9）。耶稣被圣灵恩膏去服事百姓。圣经上说：「神怎样以圣灵和能力膏了拿撒勒人耶稣，这都是你们知道的。他到处奔波，行善事，医好凡被魔鬼压制的人，因为神与他同在」（徒10:38）。

我们要离开那些拒绝我们的人(路10:10-15)

作为人，当有人拒绝我们时，我们会受到伤害。在这种情况下，我们要记住，我们不能使人成为信徒。而是圣灵使用我们的话使人知罪。圣经上说：「他来的时候，要为罪、为义，为审判，指证世人」（约16:8）。

拒绝福音的危险：

- i. 知道和拒绝比不知道要被定更大的罪。这些人曾经接受并相信耶稣基督是他们的主和救主。圣经上说：「至于那不知道而做了当受责打的事的，要少受责打。多给谁，就向谁多取；多托谁，就向谁多要。」（路12:48）。
- ii. 只是宣称有信仰是与拒绝一样。圣经上说：「光来到世上，世人因自己的行为是恶的，不爱光，倒爱黑暗，这就定了他们的罪」（约3:19）。已经变成专爱自己的信徒并不像他们所说的那样真正地爱神。他们过着虚伪的生活方式；他们告诉别人该做什么，但却不实践他们宣称的事。圣经警告我们，神如何对待这些拒绝神的人，「现在，因你们行了这一切的事，我一再警戒你们，你们却不听从；我呼唤你们，你们也不回应。这是耶和华说的。所以我要向这称为我名下、你们所倚靠的殿，与我所赐给你们和你们祖先的地这样行，正如我从前向示罗所行的。我必将你们从我眼前赶出，正如赶出你们的众弟兄，就是所有以法莲的后裔。」（耶7:13-15）。
- iii. 不断地有见证而拒绝的话，是不能逃脱地狱的后果。圣经上说：「你竟放任你刚硬不悔改的心，为自己累积愤怒！在愤怒的日子，神公义的审判要显示出来」（罗2:5）和「至于胆怯的、不信的、可憎的、杀人的、淫乱的、行邪术的、拜偶像的和一切说谎话的人，他们将在烧着硫磺的火湖里有一份；这是第二次的死」（启21:8）。

我们是神的使者(路10:16)

当我们带着天国的福音出去时，我们是神的使者。我们是神的手和脚去服事人。当人们拒绝我们的时候，神自己就被拒绝了。耶稣说道：「接纳你们的就是接纳我；接纳我的就是接纳差遣我来的那位」（太10:40）和「我实在告诉你们，这些事你们没有做在任何一个最小的弟兄身上，就是没有做在我身上了」（太25:45-46）。

神已赐给我们福音的好消息，叫我们向世人传扬和平和盼望。让我们愿意被神使用，完全依靠主为我们每一个需要的供应者。我们需要依靠圣灵的恩膏去带领人来认识耶稣基督的救恩之道。让我们祈祷并相信，在耶稣基督以万王之王和万主之主的身份再来之前，会有许多人接受耶稣基督。

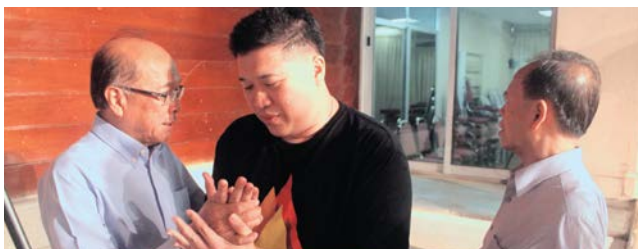

I came from a Christian family where I had the opportunity to attend Sunday school and many church activities. I have said the sinner's prayer many times. My wife, Jessica Teo, comes from a Buddhist background and when we got married, I promised her that I would not force her to attend church except during Christmas.

In my journey, I have strayed from my belief in Jesus. I started going to the temples, seeing mediums and monks to figure out how I could get around my many challenges. Then, I had an argument with my family members and I felt extremely lonely, frustrated and
