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Live in the Light

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LIVE IN THE LIGHT

John the apostle clearly establishes that if we are in fellowship with God, there is evidence we do not live and walk in darkness after our sinful nature.

1. THE EVIDENCE OF HAVING FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD IS THAT WE SHOULD LIVE AND WALK IN THE LIGHT.

John teaches that born-again believers, who are Christians and are in fellowship with God, should not continue to live like unbelievers, who live and walk in darkness. He says, *"This is the message we heard from Jesus and now declare to you: God is light, and there is no darkness in him at all. So we are lying if we say we have fellowship with God but go on living in spiritual darkness; we are not practicing the truth. But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin"* (1 John 1:5-7). They may call themselves Christians and do what is only religious, but John calls these Christians liars.

It is possible to have an intellectual knowledge of God, but not really know Him. Paul says, *"Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. As a result, their minds became dark and confused"* (Romans 1:21). God is light and there is no darkness with God. We cannot have fellowship with God and walk in darkness.

Man by nature is sinful and therefore, his behaviour is sinful. This is why Jesus had to die to redeem man from a life of sin so we can have



fellowship with God. Thus, the only way of salvation is through Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world. The Bible says, *"The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly"* (John 10:10 NKJV). Therefore, the challenge for Christians today is to truly live and walk in the light and have fellowship with God. This is the abundant life.



2. THE EVIDENCE OF A BORN-AGAIN BELIEVER IS THAT WE KNOW WE WERE SINNERS AND HAVE CONFESSED OUR SINS TO GOD.

John says, “*If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness*” (1 John 1:8-9). Sin relates to our sinful nature and behaviour. David said, “*For I was born a sinner – yes, from the moment my*

mother conceived me” (Psalm 51:5). The apostle Paul describes our hopeless sinful nature and condition. He said, “*And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't. I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from*

this life that is dominated by sin and death? Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: In my mind I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin" (Romans 7:18-20, 24-25). Therefore, man cannot have fellowship with God without confession and repentance of his sins.

3. THE EVIDENCE OF BEING A BORN AGAIN BELIEVER IS THAT OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS IS IN CHRIST.

There were believers who were convinced that they could merit right standing before God by their own efforts. John refutes this belief that we can be righteous through our own efforts. God through the prophet Isaiah said, "*We are all infected and impure with sin. When we display our righteous deeds, they are nothing but filthy rags*" (Isaiah 64:6a). Therefore, if we as Christians believe that we are capable of being righteous on our own, we fail to understand the nature of sin and the reason Jesus came to die for us. John said, "*If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts*" (1 John 1:10). If we believe that our education, wealth, and cultural upbringing can make us acceptable to God, then Jesus died in vain. The only way we are able to live and walk in the light is to confess we are sinners saved by grace and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. As long as we are living on earth, we may falter and sin because we are still in the flesh. Satan will accuse and condemn us of our sins. But John tells us, "*My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous*" (1 John 2:1). Jesus is our righteous advocate and Saviour. Our righteousness is not of our own. It was accomplished when Jesus took our sins and died for us on the cross.



Therefore, let us not allow the enemy to deceive us into thinking that we can walk in darkness, yet have fellowship with God. Instead, we need to be born again in order for us to walk in the light. We need to recognise that we are sinful beings and we cannot be righteous before God in our own efforts and good works. In order for us to be born again, we need to believe in Jesus for our salvation. Paul taught, "*For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord*" (Romans 6:23). The Bible says, "*There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved*" (Acts 4:12). Acknowledging that we are sinners, may we not be ashamed in confessing our sins to God and repenting of our sins, for John said, "*But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness*" (1 John 1:9). Let us continue to live out our Christian faith in total dependence on Jesus Christ, as we walk and live in His light in obedience to Him.

Ever had the desire to connect with a potential believer through sharing your testimony, but got tongue-tied or your testimony all jumbled up? Ever wanted to join the E-Team (Evangelism Team), but found evangelism daunting? Has the fear of rejection held you back from reaching out?

Recognising these obstacles, E-Talk, an evangelism training, was held on Sunday, 14 July 2019 at Calvary Convention Centre to empower Calvarites to participate in evangelism efforts.

Associate Pastor Richard Yun and Gan Chew, the E-Team Coordinator, shared their testimonies and implored us to practice witnessing. Relating to the potential believer is important: we must listen to their story, identify the push and pull factors affecting them, and then communicate Christ. As practice, we grouped together, and using the 1-Minute Witness method, shared a truth that touched us with power and conviction. This helped to prepare us to share Christ with potential believers.

Forty-two out of 67 participants decided to put to practice what they learnt by responding for field experience and involvement in evangelism. Seventeen were recruited to reach out to the community through visitations and to pray for the sick and needy.

PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL IN BOTH WORD AND DEED

As believers, our primary call is the Great Commission, to evangelise and to proclaim the Gospel.

“Then Jesus came to them and said, ‘All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age’ ” (Matthew 28:18-20 NIV).

So how do we do this? Do we have conversations to build rapport with potential believers while having the hidden agenda of evangelising? Should we constantly grapple with the question of when to segue into the topic? ‘Missing the chance’ can guilt us into thinking that we ‘let God down’. Proclaiming the Gospel then turns into a task, a great weight.

Besides proclaiming the Gospel, we are also to demonstrate good works. How do we balance the two, and how do we decide which one has more priority? Is it acceptable to do one and not the other? Integral missions involves saying, doing, and being people of the Kingdom. Both proclamation and demonstration are fundamental aspects of God, and therefore are connected to our lives as believers.

The real question for us to ask ourselves is what the Father’s heart is turned to for the particular situation, person, or community in question. There is no fixed formula. Instead of strategising for the ‘best moment’ to talk about Jesus, or to focus solely on immediate needs, we should strive to make God known in the way that He wants in any given moment. He alone knows what is truly needed, and we need to listen and obey the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Integral missions is proclamation and demonstration going hand-in-hand together in our daily lives and expressions in order to truly reflect God.

Indeed, it is a very tall order of the mission to which God calls us. It requires the gifts and the resources of the whole church! That is why the church needs to be a catalyst for holistic Christian living and being, to cultivate and foster a culture of active transformational engagement with our society today.

MINDFUL EATING

A recent The Star newspaper headline reads, “Malaysians lack nutritional knowledge.” The Dimensions talk on Mindful Eating on Saturday, 27 July 2019 saw a turnout of 125 ladies, and could not be more timely.

In a light-hearted manner, consultant dietitian Mary Easaw, recipient of the 2016 Outstanding Dietitian of the Year Award by the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics, USA shared her wealth of experience with us. She began with the history of her diet from 20-60 years old and the nutrition needed for each age bracket. The ladies were enlightened on the pros and cons of various fad diets such as the keto diet, Mediterranean diet, and intermittent fasting. She highlighted that there is no such thing as good and

bad food; only good and bad eating habits. The key is variety, moderation, and balance. The rule of thumb is “suku, suku, separuh”, which is to fill $\frac{1}{4}$ of the plate with complex carbohydrates, $\frac{1}{4}$ with proteins, and $\frac{1}{2}$ with colourful fruits and vegetables.

She gave some practical tips on mindful eating which entails paying attention to our reasons for eating and how we feel before, during and after eating, listening to our body and stopping when full, chewing more than usual, and eating at set times.

The ladies thoroughly enjoyed the lively, insightful talk. The probing question Mary posed aptly summed it all, “Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. Are you in the best spiritual and physical condition to serve the Lord?”

HIDUP DI DALAM TERANG

Rasul Yohanes dengan jelas menetapkan bahawa jika kita berada dalam persekutuan dengan Tuhan, adanya bukti bahawa kita tidak hidup dan berjalan dalam kegelapan dan bergantung kepada sifat dosa kita.

1. BUKTI MEMILIKI PERSEKUTUAN DENGAN TUHAN ADALAH, KITA HIDUP DAN BERJALAN DI DALAM TERANG.

Yohanes mengajarkan bahawa orang percaya yang dilahirkan kembali, yang adalah orang Kristian dan bersekutu dengan Tuhan, hendaknya tidak terus

hidup seperti orang yang tidak percaya, yang hidup dan berjalan dalam kegelapan. Dia berkata, “Dan inilah berita, yang telah kami dengar dari Dia, dan yang kami sampaikan kepada kamu: Tuhan adalah terang dan di dalam Dia sama sekali tidak ada kegelapan. Jika kita katakan, bahwa kita beroleh persekutuan dengan Dia, namun kita hidup di dalam kegelapan, kita berdusta dan kita tidak melakukan kebenaran. Tetapi jika kita hidup di dalam terang sama seperti Dia ada di dalam terang, maka kita beroleh persekutuan seorang dengan yang lain, dan darah Yesus, Anak-Nya itu, menyucikan kita dari pada segala dosa” (1 Yohanes 1:5-7). Mereka mungkin menyebut diri mereka Kristian dan melakukan apa yang hanya saleh, tetapi Yohanes menyebut orang Kristian ini pembohong.

Adanya kemungkinan untuk memiliki pengetahuan intelektual tentang Tuhan tetapi tidak benar-benar mengenalNya. Paulus berkata, “Sebab



sekalipun mereka mengenal Tuhan, mereka tidak memuliakan Dia sebagai Tuhan atau mengucap syukur kepada-Nya. Sebaliknya pikiran mereka menjadi sia-sia dan hati mereka yang bodoh menjadi gelap” (Roma 1:21). Tuhan itu terang dan tidak ada kegelapan dengan Tuhan. Kita tidak boleh memiliki persekutuan dengan Tuhan dan hidup dalam kegelapan pada masa yang sama.

Manusia, pada dasarnya berdosa dan kerana itu perilakunya berdosa. Inilah sebabnya Yesus harus mati untuk menebus manusia dari kehidupan dosa sehingga kita dapat bersekutu dengan Tuhan. Dengan demikian, satu-satunya cara keselamatan adalah melalui Yesus Kristus, yang adalah terang dunia. Alkitab berkata, “Pencuri datang hanya untuk mencuri dan membunuh dan membincaskan; Aku datang, supaya mereka mempunyai hidup, dan mempunyainya dalam segala kelimpahan” (Yohanes 10:10). Kerana itu, cabaran bagi orang Kristian dewasa ini adalah untuk benar-benar hidup dan berjalan dalam terang dengan bersekutu dengan Tuhan. Inilah hidup yang berkelimpahan.

2. BUKTI SEORANG UMAT KRISTIAN YANG PERCAYA ADALAH KITA TAHU KITA BERDOSA DAN TELAH MENGAKUI DOSA KITA KEPADA TUHAN.

Yohanes berkata, “Jika kita berkata, bahwa kita tidak berdosa, maka kita menipu diri kita sendiri dan kebenaran tidak ada di dalam kita. Jika kita mengaku dosa kita, maka la adalah setia dan adil, sehingga la akan mengampuni segala dosa kita dan menyucikan kita dari segala kejahatan” (1 Yohanes 1:8-9). Dosa berhubungan dengan sifat dan perilaku kita yang berdosa. Daud berkata, “Sesungguhnya, dalam kesalahan aku diperanakkan, dalam dosa aku dikandung ibuku” (Mazmur 51:5). Rasul Paulus menggambarkan sifat dan keadaan berdosa kita yang tanpa harapan. Dia berkata, “Sebab aku tahu, bahwa di dalam aku, yaitu di dalam aku sebagai manusia, tidak ada sesuatu yang baik. Sebab kehendak memang ada di dalam aku, tetapi bukan

hal berbuat apa yang baik. Sebab bukan apa yang aku kehendaki, yaitu yang baik, yang aku perbuat, melainkan apa yang tidak aku kehendaki, yaitu yang jahat, yang aku perbuat. Jadi jika aku berbuat apa yang tidak aku kehendaki, maka bukan lagi aku yang memperbuatnya, tetapi dosa yang diam di dalam aku. Aku, manusia celaka! Siapakah yang akan melepaskan aku dari tubuh maut ini? Syukur kepada Tuhan! oleh Yesus Kristus, Tuhan kita. Jadi dengan akal budiku aku melayani hukum Tuhan, tetapi dengan tubuh insaniku aku melayani hukum dosa” (Roma 7:18-20, 24-25). Kerana itu, manusia tidak dapat memiliki persekutuan dengan Tuhan tanpa pertobatan dan pengakuan dosa-dosanya.

3. BUKTI SEORANG UMAT KRISTIAN YANG LAHIR BARU ADALAH KEBENARAN KITA DALAM KRISTUS.

Ada orang-orang percaya yang yakin bahwa mereka dapat memperoleh kedudukan yang benar di hadapan Tuhan dalam keupayaan mereka sendiri. Yohanes membantah kepercayaan bahawa kita dapat menjadi orang benar melalui keupayaan kita sendiri. Tuhan melalui Nabi Yesaya berkata, “Demikianlah kami sekalian seperti seorang najis dan segala kesalehan kami seperti kain kotor” (Yesaya 64:6a). Kerana itu, jika kita sebagai orang Kristian percaya bahawa kita sanggup menjadi orang benar dengan sendiri, kita gagal untuk memahami sifat dosa dan sebab kenapa Yesus datang untuk mati bagi kita. Yohanes berkata, “Jika kita berkata, bahwa kita tidak ada berbuat dosa, maka kita membuat Dia menjadi pendusta dan firman-Nya tidak ada di dalam kita” (1 Yohanes 1:10). Jika kita percaya bahwa pendidikan, kekayaan, dan pendidikan budaya kita dapat membuat kita diterima Tuhan, maka Yesus mati hanya sia-sia. Satu-satunya cara kita dapat hidup dan berjalan dalam terang adalah dengan mengakui bahawa kita adalah orang berdosa yang diselamatkan oleh kasih karunia melalui Yesus Kristus. Selama kita hidup di bumi, kita mungkin goyah dan berdosa kerana kita masih di dalam daging. Setan akan menuduh dan menghukum kita

atas dosa-dosa kita. Tetapi, Yohanes memberi tahu kita, “Anak-anakku, hal-hal ini kutuliskan kepada kamu, supaya kamu jangan berbuat dosa, namun jika seorang berbuat dosa, kita mempunyai seorang pengantara pada Bapa, yaitu Yesus Kristus, yang adil” (1 Yohanes 2:1). Yesus adalah pembela kita yang benar. Kebenaran kita bukan milik kita sendiri. Itu terjadi ketika Yesus menanggung dosa kita dan mati untuk kita di kayu salib.

Kerana itu, jangan biarkan musuh menipu kita untuk berfikir bahawa kita dapat berjalan dalam kegelapan, namun bersekutu dengan Tuhan. Sebaliknya, kita perlu dilahirkan kembali agar kita dapat berjalan dalam terang. Kita perlu menyedari bahawa kita adalah makhluk berdosa dan kita tidak dapat menjadi orang benar di hadapan Tuhan dengan usaha dan perbuatan baik kita sendiri. Agar kita dilahirkan kembali, kita perlu percaya kepada Yesus untuk keselamatan kita. Paulus berkata, “Sebab upah dosa ialah maut; tetapi karunia Tuhan ialah hidup yang kekal dalam Kristus Yesus, Tuhan kita” (Roma 6:23). Alkitab berkata, “Dan keselamatan tidak ada di dalam siapapun juga selain di dalam Dia, sebab di bawah kolong langit ini tidak ada nama lain yang diberikan kepada manusia yang olehnya kita dapat diselamatkan” (Kisah Para Rasul 4:12). Kita harus mengakui bahawa kita adalah orang berdosa dan tidak malu mengaku dosa dan bertobat. Yohanes berkata, “Jika kita mengaku dosa kita, maka Ia adalah setia dan adil, sehingga Ia akan mengampuni segala dosa kita dan menyucikan kita dari segala kejahatan” (1 Yohanes 1: 9). Marilah kita terus menjalani iman Kristian kita dalam persekutuan dengan Tuhan dan hidup sebagai saksi akan kuasa Injil Yesus Kristus.

活在光中

徒约翰清楚表明，如果我们与神相通，我们就不会因着罪性而生活在黑暗中。

1. 与神相通的证据——活在光中，行在光中。

约翰教导，重生的信徒就是与神相通的基督徒，不能像不信的人一样仍行在黑暗中。他说：“我们把所看见所听见的向你们宣扬：神是光，在他里面毫无黑暗；这就是我们从他那里听见，现在传给你们的信息。我们若说自己与他彼此相通，却行在黑暗里，就是说谎话，不实行真理了。我们若行在光中，像他在光中一样，就彼此相通，他儿子耶稣的血也洁净我们脱离一切罪。”（约翰一书1:5-7）宣称自己是基督徒，行事却只像个宗教徒，约翰称他们为骗子。我们或许在知识层面上知道神，却没有真正地认识他。保罗说：“因为他们虽然知道神，却不尊他为神，也不感谢他，反而心思变为虚妄，愚顽的心就迷糊了。”（罗马书1:21）神是光，在他里面没有丝毫黑暗。我们不能与他相通的同时却行在黑暗中。人类本性有罪，因此他的行为也有罪。这就是为什么耶稣必须死去才能救赎人类，使人脱离罪恶，与神相通。人得救的唯一管道是透过耶稣基督，他是世界的光。圣经上说：“贼来了，不过是要偷窃、杀害、毁坏；我来了，是要使羊得生命，并且得的更丰盛。”（约翰福音10:10）因此，今天基督徒的挑战是要有真正与神相通并活在光中。而这才是丰盛的生命。


2. 信徒重生的证据——知道自己是个罪人，并向神承认自己的罪。

约翰说：“我们若说自己没有罪，就是自欺，真理就不在我们里面了。我们若承认自己的罪，神是

信实的、公义的，必定赦免我们的罪，洁净我们脱离一切不义。”（约翰一书1:8-9）罪与我们的罪性和行为息息相关。大卫说：“看哪，我是在罪孽里生的；我母亲在罪中怀了我。”（诗篇51:5）使徒保罗解释了我们无助的罪性与行为。他说：“我知道在我里面，就是在我肉体之中，没有良善，因为立志行善由得我，行出来却由不得我。所以我愿意行的善，我没有去行；我不愿意作的恶，我倒去作了。我若作自己不愿意作的事，那就不是我作的，而是住在我里面的罪作的。我这个人真是苦啊！谁能救我脱离这使我死亡的身体呢？感谢神，借着我们的主耶稣基督就能脱离了。可见，一方面我自己心里服事神的律，另一方面我的肉体却服事罪的律。”（罗马书7:18-20，24-25）人若不悔改承认自己的罪就不能与神相通。

3. 信徒重生的证据——我们是在基督里称义。

有些信徒相信，他们可以透过自己的努力在神面前称义。约翰反驳了靠行为称义的论述。神透过以赛亚先知说：“我们众人都像不洁净的人，我们所有的义，都像污秽的衣”（以赛亚书64:6a）。因此，如果基督徒相信可以靠行为称义，就是还没认识到人的罪性，也不了解耶稣是为了救赎我们而死的。约翰说：“我们若说自己没有犯过罪，就是把神当作说谎的，他的道就不在我们心里了”（约翰一书1:10）。如果我们相信能靠着教育、财富和文化教养使我们在神面前称义，那么耶稣就白白死了。我们能活在光中的唯一方法就是承认我们是罪人并靠着耶稣基督的恩典蒙救赎。我们只要还活着就有可能信心动摇并犯罪，因为我们仍然活在肉体之中。撒但会指责并控诉我们的罪。可是，约翰告诉我们：“我的孩子们，我写这些给你们，是要你们不犯罪。如果有人犯了罪，在父的面前我们有一位维护者，就是那义者耶稣基督。”（约翰一书2:1）耶稣是我们公义的中保。我们不能靠自己称义，唯有靠着主耶稣背负了我们的罪被钉死在十字架上才得以称义。



因此，不要被仇敌给骗了，以为在与神相通的同时仍可以活在黑暗中。相反地，我们需要得到重生才能行在光明之中。我们要意识到自己有罪，知道不能透过努力行善在神面前称义。我们唯有相信耶稣才能得到救恩，并获得重生。保罗说：“因为罪的工价就是死，但神的恩赏，在我们的主基督耶稣里，却是永生。”（罗马书6:23）。圣经上说：“除了他以外，别无拯救，因为在天下人间，没有赐下别的名，我们可以靠着得救。”（使徒行传4:12）我们得承认自己是个罪人，不必为着认罪并诚心悔改而觉得羞耻。约翰说：“我们若承认自己的罪，神是信实的、公义的，必定赦免我们的罪，洁净我们脱离一切不义。”（约翰一书1:9）让我们与神相通，继而活出基督信仰，成为耶稣基督福音有力的见证。。

Calvary Prayer Tower's purpose of having prayer closets is to provide a quiet place for believers to use when they sense the need to seek God personally.


